Food Still Plentiful Despite Air Raiding

Fresh Meat, Bacon, Butter and Sugar are Rationed; Other Edibles in Quantity. (Editor's Note: What about food in England today? You will find the answer in the following article by Milo M. Thompson, another in his series of 12 stories on life in that country. Tomorrow: "Evacuation Without Stampede.")

New York, Dec. 20.—(AP)—Some of us take a market basket and go looking for food in my own little suburban shopping district of London today. We take a double-deck bus almost at my door and pay three pence (three cents) for the ride that in previous days was a penny one. We pass the public gardens, the tennis courts, cricket pitch, bowling green and golf club of the neighborhood and note people seriously at the work of "rationing" food. We pass many brick houses with pleasant gardens.

Some of the houses are not so tidy as they once were, due to broken glass but most of the wreckage stores at its own expense today. We stop off at the English equivalent of the American "five and ten" store, a "convenience and excellence" store.

Store Has Food Counters. There is always something needed in such a place. This crowded store has its food counters too. They are full of canned soups, fruits, galatinas, fish such as sardines and kipper mackerel, milk, packaged cheese, jelly, softening flour, dried fruits and the like. There is plenty of tea cakes and candy. No ration cards here and an starvation for the fellow who has a suspense.

But we are after more sturdy stuff and go out again to the next market. It is early in the day and we find in the windows, behind the roaring and steaming cuts of strictly rationed beef, mutton and veal hanging on their silver trays of unrationed "edible offals."

Supply Doesn't Last Long. There are hearts, kidneys, liver, tripe and the like, and sausages which are half meat and half bread crumbs, the most "content of sausage being prescribed by law. One has to snap these things up quickly, for one minute there, because the day's supply does not last many hours. But you can stop for still where you please, because you must get for bacon, butter, sugar, cooking fats and tinned meat to
