Belgrano became commanderin-chief of Argentina's armies. Although independence was not formally declared until 1816, the Argentine republic dates from his victories over Peruvian loyalists

Beigrano played an important part in the Congress of 1816 where independence was formally pro-claimed. He also undertook a diplomatic mission to England to seek British support.




