Washington—When this news gets around, the "pigeon protection" bill of Dr. Joseph L. Pfeifer, Brooklyn congressman, medico and fancier, is probably going to have a lot more chance of consideration than it has had in recent sessions.

The news is that the U. S. signal corps is interesting itself in the registration (for possible use in defense emergency) of the country's trained homing pigeons. The signal corps has dispatch ridera, telephone and telegraph lines, wireless and radio, but when all lines are out, the circuits dead, and riders cas't get through, there's nothing so handy, it seems, a a homer that can wing its way back to headquarters.

The signal corps has pigeons—lots of them—but as a means of binilding a reserve supply, the corps plans to ask all private fanciers to register their lofts. This way, the army figures, it could, in en emergency, get about 50,000 trained pigeons in no time at all. Used By Spies

Stories keep drifting in from England about the use of homing pigeons in the present war, particularly in getting information back from the continent, where it is reported Great Britain has an elaborate spy system, abetted by thousands of persons in German-controlled territory who are willing to take all sorts of risks to






