

## Lease-Lend Bill's Passage Urged by Conn.'s Assembly

### Heated Debate in House Precedes Vote of 187 To 36 But Senate Is Prompt in Adopting Approving Resolution; Forest Bonds Urged.

Hartford, Feb. 27.—(AP)—The Connecticut Legislature adopted a resolution today calling on the state's congressional contingent to assist in speedy enactment of the lease-lend bill. The resolution, introduced by the Rev. E. C. Carpenter (R., East Haven), who was one of Calvin Coolidge's boyhood teachers, was approved by a rising vote of 187 to 36 in the House and immediately sped to the Senate.

## Powder Mill Blast Hurts One Worker

### Sharp Explosion Rocks Bay State Plant Today; Concussion Felt 14 Miles from Its Scene.

Acton, Mass., Feb. 27.—(AP)—A sharp explosion today rocked a plant in the black powder action to The American Powder Company, sending at least one man to the hospital with apparently serious injuries.

The company's various powder mills are spread over a wide area near here, with an eye to minimizing the effects of an explosion, and this apparently was instrumental in confining the blast to a single building.

The explosion was felt as far away as Framingham, 14 miles distant.

Shortly after a column of black smoke rose over the powder plant, a man was swept into the Emerson hospital at Concord, Mass., about ten miles from Acton. Doctors were unable to report immediately on his condition, but a nurse said he appeared to be "serious."

Residents in nearby Maynard reported hearing an explosion shortly after noon-time and said they saw black smoke about a mile away in the vicinity of The American Powder Company plant.

One report from Maynard householder said the explosion sounded like a sharp thump, as if someone had dropped a heavy chair.

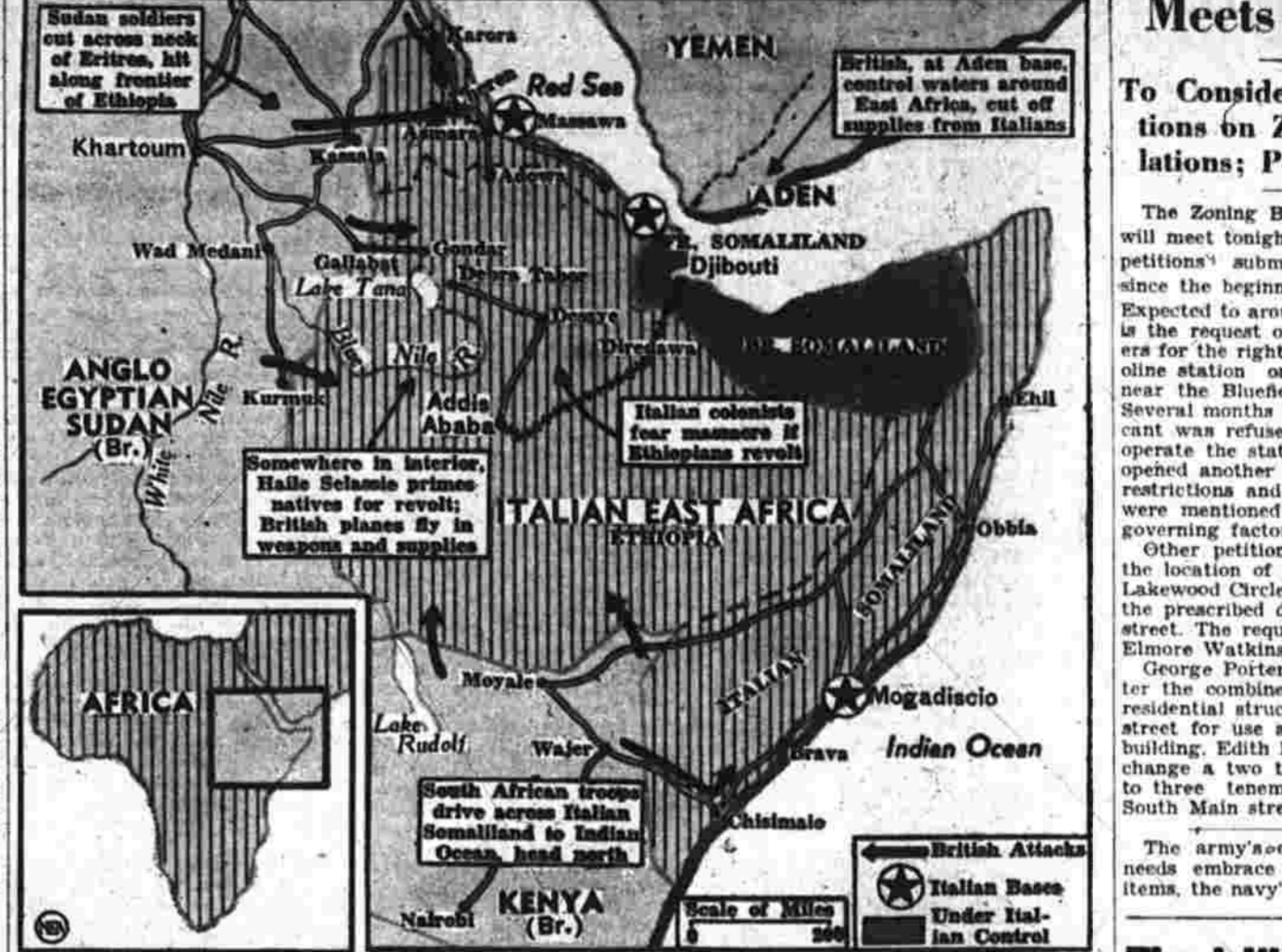
