French to Convoy Vessels If British Keep Up Blockade

Darlan Says He Will Be Obligated to Ask Permission to Provide Arms and Protection For Merchantmen to Get Food for Nation.

Vichy, France, March 10.—(P)—Vice Premier Admiral Jean Darlan informed American press representatives today that French ships would be convoyed if the British blockade of France continued. Darlan, who with Chief of State Marshal Philippe Pétain and Secretary of Food Supply Jean Achard called the press conference, declared: "If the British continue this blockade, which I consider inhumane, I will be obliged to ask permission to provide arms and protection for our merchantmen. I will let nothing stand in the way of the French people's existence. The Germans are more generous and more comprehensive of the needs of humanity than the English," he continued.

German Release Wheat.
Pétain said the Germans had released 2,000,000 quintals (20,400,000 bushels) of wheat out of 2,700,000 which had been requisitioned for the German army.

Darlan said he considered the blockade against Germany useless and declared he had told that to U. S. Ambassador Admiral William D. Leahy last night.

A few boatloads of wheat will not affect the outcome of the war, he said.

Achard read a prepared statement in which he said 5,000,000 quintals (50,400,000 bushels) of wheat from the United States were needed for the unoccupied zone of France.

The French government has communicated to the American government the urgency of obtaining and transporting that amount of wheat, he said.

Base Sites Gain Favor Of Senate

Action on Authorization For Public Works Puts Seal of Approval on Destroyers Exchange.

Washington, March 10.—(P)—The Senate approved today establishment of Naval air base sites acquired from Britain in exchange for United States destroyers, an action which the Senate Naval Committee said would have the effect of "congressional ratification" of the exchange.

The action came when the Senate passed a \$245,228,000 authorization for Naval public works, including besides the work at the Pearl Harbor, development of facilities at Gosport and Sams, in the Atlantic area, at various other Pacific locations, in the Canal Zone, in the Caribbean and in continental United States.

The Naval Committee reported that the total \$245,228,000 represented the amount necessary to base on British soil.

The measure goes back to the Senate's approval of the exchange of destroyers for base sites.

The action comes when the Senate is passing legislation which would authorize the construction of a new destroyer base at Gosport, Va., and the acquisition of base sites at Sams, Va., and in the Canal Zone.

The bill is expected to pass the Senate in the next few weeks.
