

Savings Bank Life Insurance Plan Is Passed by Senate

Republicans Criticize Democrats for Demanding Hasty Action in Bill; Approved Without Record Vote; Shea in Favor of Act.

State Capitol, Hartford, March 20.—(AP)—The Senate passed today a measure authorizing savings banks to issue small life insurance after a debate in which Republicans, although most of them supported the bill, criticized Democrats for demanding "hasty" action. The bill, which now goes to the House Republican-controlled Banking Committee is still studying its provisions, was passed without a record vote. The only senator flatly to oppose the bill in debate was Frank Simmons, Enfield Republican who is in the insurance business. Republican Leader William J. Shea voted for the measure but regretted the Democrats did not permit members "an opportunity to study" its provisions. Chairman Michael Blagofield (D) of the Banking Committee charged during the debate that opponents of the proposal, included in Governor Hiram's legislative program, had disseminated "misinformation" as a propaganda "concerning the plan." He told the Senate the legislation would "greatly benefit the working man and his family" because he could not afford to pay for life insurance himself. The size of a policy a bank could issue to any individual would be limited to \$1,000 under the act and the total insurance an individual might obtain would be limited to \$3,000.

British Subs Sink Italian Supply Ships

London, March 20.—(AP)—Three British submarines pounced on Italian convoys sank two heavily-laden supply vessels, "almost certainly" destroyed another, and scored hits on two crowded troop transports, one of which "is considered certain was completely destroyed," the Admiralty announced today.

Saigon, French Indo-China, March 20.—(AP)—Widespread reports which The Associated Press said today, the Japanese are planning within the next two weeks to send 100,000 troops from French Indo-China into Thailand. After traveling Indo-China, the reports said, the Japanese either would proceed to Bangkok, go to the Malay or turn southeast toward the Burma border in an attempt to isolate Chungking, capital of the Central Chinese government, and prevent the movement of military supplies over the Burma road.

Local Boys Are Getting Used to Routine; Like Camp Life.

Camp Blanding, March 19.—(Special)—Our troops arrived at a beautiful Florida scrubby afternoon, Saturday the 19th, all safe and sound. Dressed in their full winter uniforms, including the heavy overcoats, they marched with packs on their backs to the railroad station on the camp grounds, to their camp site, about two miles away. With the temperature at about seventy degrees, everyone was glad to remove their heavy clothing and get down to the task of unloading the baggage and arranging their tents.

Prime plum-puller under the tent was Charles F. Palmer, Atlanta real estate man who holds the position of defense housing co-ordinator. If you have wondered what these co-ordinators do in the defense organization sector, you'll see that they are doing a lot of things.

Palmer doesn't administer one cent of the half-billion dollars available for defense housing, but he is responsible for making the housing program and then coordinating the work of 14 other government agencies all with a share of the job.

\$337 Million For Housing

Just recently, the president plunked out the housing co-ordinating job to the Knudsen defense housing organization, gave Palmer real authority, responsible for the work of 14 other government agencies all with a share of the job.

His camp site, located amidst thousands of other tents and barracks, is about three and one-half miles from the main gate. Our company occupies about twenty five wood-frame tents. These tents are the regular camp tents used by the local defense housing organization, and the space below the bottom of the canvas is filled in with concrete blocks. At the same time the frame structure is screened with canvas and wood floors. Our tents are all equipped with electric lights and are very comfortable. The electric lights were not installed when we arrived, but they have been completed by noon and should be in use by tomorrow.

When we were up home in Connecticut and read in the paper that the local defense housing organization had been given the job of administering the work of 14 other government agencies all with a share of the job, it seemed to be a joke. It was not until Monday morning, when Sidney B. Tober had been notified by the local board of his appointment to the job, that we knew it was no joke.

Eight of the 20 men examined by the local board yesterday were given Class A assignment and will be ready for induction probably on April 10. However, no official notice has been received by the local board of which date the seventh local call will be made. To Monday's group 21 will go from Manchester and on Saturday, the 20th two men will report from this town.

Canada Adds To Training Compulsory Service For Four Months

Ottawa, Canada, March 20.—(AP)—Abandoning the policy of a 21-month compulsory military training, Canada's compulsory service administration called up 4,600 men in the first unit to receive four months of military training.
