





America's Men of Science

Dr. V. K. Zworykin--Speeds Television By Perfecting Electrical 'Human Eye'

By Watson Davis Director, Science Eervice Written for NEA Service

To Dr. V. K. Zworykin, Russianborn master of electrons, we owe, more than to any other person, television as it is today.

Before the depression television got a false start, using the older mechanical methods. A dozen or so television broadcastings went on the air with eight and sound, but the quality was not sufficiently good to interest the public. The infant industry seemed to be atymied by the technical limitation of the mechanical impossibility of of the mechanical impossibility of scanning a scene or reproducing an image speedily enough. Then along came Zworykin with electronic television. He invented the iconoscope (literally "image observer") which is the closest artificial imitation of the human

The iconoscope has no scanning disk or other moving parts. The only thing about it that moves is a thin stream of electrons, a cathode ray, played back and forth across a sensitive artificial "retina" by changes in a magnetic

Television Is Ready New Dr. Zworykin also invented t stream plays rapidly back and forth across the screen which shines when the electrons bombard it, thus reproducing the original televised scene. Dozens of others have developed various aspects of television so that it is a perfected accomplish-ment ready for public usage. But Dr. Zworykin is one of the great-





Would be moved out to sea immediately upon completion, and armament of the ships would be placed in such condition that it could not be used while in the Great Lakes.

Contracts for construction of a number of small craft, such as minesweepers and submarine chasers, already have been let by the U. S. Navy in anticipation of the agreement. Administration leaders pointed out that construction of larger vessels in the area would be practicable if Congress approved the St. Lawrence seaway proposal.
