

Plans Laid Long Ago

Long ago the Yugoslav generals, heirs to a fierce military tradition running back 1,000 years, laid plans in case of an attack by Italians and German armies.

Early today the government announced that Belgrade, the Croat capital of Zagreb, and the Slovene capital of Ljubljana would not be defended.

Belgrade is about 50 miles from Rumania, Zagreb about 50 miles from Hungary and Ljubljana about 20 miles from Italy and Germany. With Germany's mechanized divisions massed on the Yugoslav frontier in Rumania, Hungary and old Austria, the Yugoslav general staff expects those cities would be quickly captured. The war would be taken to

The Yugoslavs intend to have a hand in that fight too if war comes to their kingdom. 4. A main attack from Kyustendil, southern Bulgaria, through mountain passes in an attempt to capture Skoplje and cut off Yugoslavia from Greece and the British forces there.

To Defend Mountain Passes
Large numbers of Yugoslav soldiers are concentrated along the southern Yugoslav-Bulgarian frontier across from Kyustendil to defend the mountain passes and keep open the channel between Greece and Yugoslavia.

Yugoslavia has a frontier of some 1,900 miles, of which friendly Greece takes up only 162 miles.

Military observers don't expect the campaign—if war comes—to be in the grand manner.




