Steel Mill Leaders Gather for Parley; Ford Plants Closed

Production in Gigantic Network Halted By CIO Strike as Completely as During 1937 Sit-Downs in General Motors and Chrysler; 41 Communities Now Affected.

Detroit, April 5.—(AP)—Production in the gigantic industrial network of Ford Motor Company plants was halted today by a CIO strike as completely as was the automotive production of General Motors and Chrysler corporations during the 1937 sit-downs of the same union.

Suppliers from whom the company said it has purchased \$11,000,000 worth of material weekly since Jan. 1 were notified to stop further shipments.

118,000 Workers Made Idle. Ford company spokesmen said 118,000 of its production workers have been made idle by the strike.

Washington, April 5.—(AP)—With important defense measures out of the way, members of Congress were leaving Washington today for a week's spring vacation before tackling the controversial question of new taxes, convicts and labor disputes.

The House recessed earlier this week until April 14 and the Senate arranged to reconvene next week.

Before knocking off for a week, the Senate passed legislation, already approved by the House to extend for two years the bituminous coal act under which the government fixed minimum soft coal prices.

Eyes On Axis Ships

The Italian freighter Villaperosa, anchored at Wilmington, C. S., was the way of other shipping on the Cape Fear River. Naval officials decided to have her moved up the river.

They boarded the ship, found her shambles, her machinery battered and completely dismantled. Naval intelligence officers promptly set to work and learned that other Italian ships were on their way to the Gulf and around the Cape Guardafui to the Pacific northwest.

The sabotage, which President Roosevelt indicated he ordered personally was under a World War statute which permits any disabled ship to be taken over to prevent damage or injury to the harbor or the waters of the United States.

Twenty of the Italian ships were found on the coast of the United States. The master of one said the sabotage had been ordered by an Italian naval attaché. Thereafter, U. S. demanded the attaché, Admiral Lata, be recalled.

Technically the ships were only "protective custody" to prevent damage to them. President Roosevelt had nothing to say about their eventual disposition, but the law provides that any ship actually sabotaged be forfeited to the U. S.

Latin Follow Our Example Such ships, when reconditioned, might possibly be fed into the present rate of shipping turned over to Great Britain under the lease-lend act. But every one of the 200 tons seized in U. S. harbors were put into the British service.

Hitler Passes Up A Nazi Deadline

Washington

ADOLF HITLER has been harried for several months by threats from the Italian partner's face. Early in the week he found his own 'being scrutinized for strain.

When Yugoslavia sassed back, Hitler was slow in cracking down. One German explanation was that "We will not let a street mob determine our policies. Germany, an opinion of the situation after the fashion of a man of letters."

Midnight Monday was the reported deadline set by Germany for her nationalities to leave Yugoslavia. Nazi sources said Germany then would deliver an ultimatum for Yugoslavia to demobilize or face invasion.

As the zero hour approached, Yugoslavia's new premier, General Dusan Simovic, told his countrymen to stand firm. Germans in Berlin said their government was showing "unexampled patience" but added frankly: "The Reich cannot stand for having its prestige endangered."

The German minister, Viktor von Heiden, hurried to Berlin. On Tuesday, after nothing happened, authorized German informants in Berlin acknowledged that they were unable to comment on political matters in Belgrade.

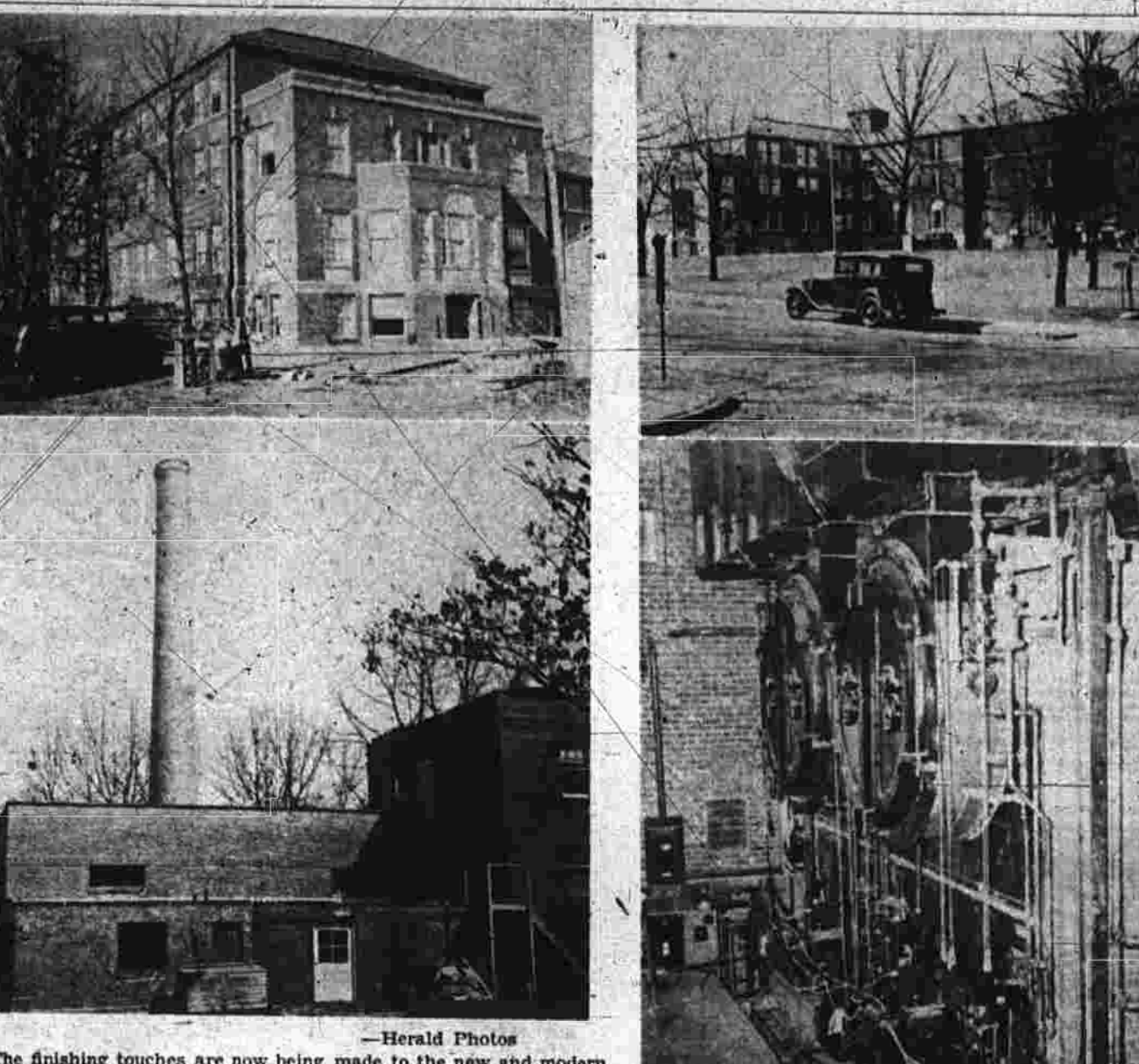

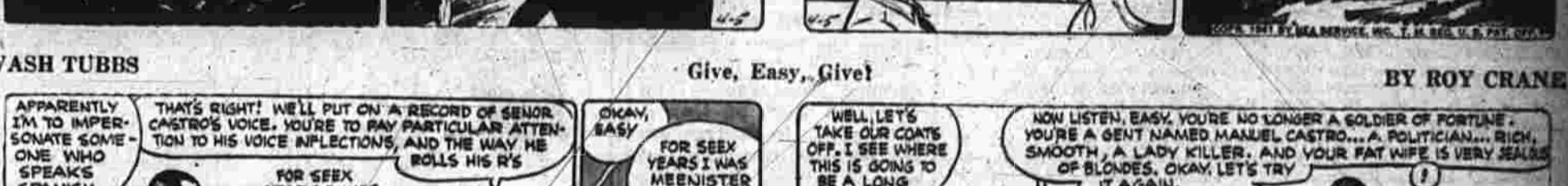
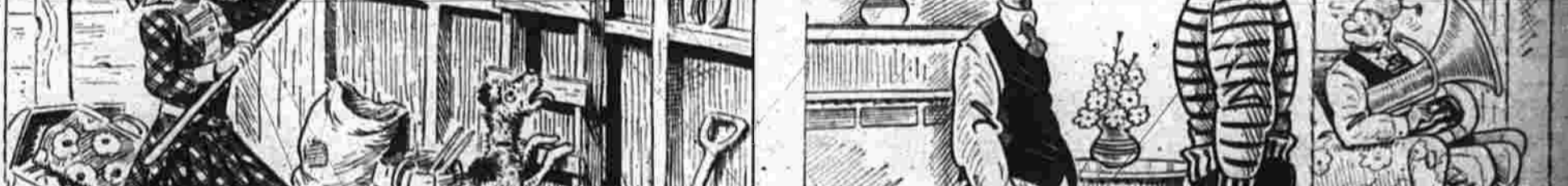

Zone Changes Up Wednesday

Fairlands Corporation To Present its Petition To Local Board.

Continuance of the public interest in zoning matters is foreseen as the Board of Zoning Commissioners makes ready for a hearing next Wednesday at which it will be proposed that the minimum frontage of a lot in an A Residence zone be increased from the present 50 feet to a new length of 60 feet.

Plan 240 New Homes In addition to the hearing on the amending of the present regulations to permit this increase, the Board will consider a petition of the Fairlands Exchange corporation that property off Adams street on the east side, and off Middle turnpike west, on the south side of that highway, be changed from a rural to A Residence zone.

No far there does not appear to be any opposition to the request. If the rural zone is not changed, it will be impossible to divide the land into lots for small homes since the rural areas call for large land allotments with each dwelling.

In connection with the first business item that one calling for a change in frontage from 50 to 60 feet in an A Residence zone, it is expected that many real estate men and property owners who already have plans for development of property, will appear in opposition. If passed, will affect property already taken out, but not developed. If it is intended to do this, it is possible the opposition will be increased although it is understood that many developers already have 60 foot frontages.

There is no apparent reason for the increase other than that of space and area per house. A larger lot, even one increased by only 10 feet, is held more desirable than the present size, and tends to improve the appearance of a neighborhood, it is said.
