

## Engineer Is Killed As Trains Collide In East Hartford

### Freight from Boston Crashes into Rear of Switching Engine; 9 Cars Derailed; Crews Have a Narrow Escape from Death.

Charles Green, 70, engineer of a switching engine in the East Hartford New Haven railroad yards was fatally injured and several crewmen of the switcher and a freight train, bound from Boston to Hartford narrowly escaped injury when the through freight crashed into the rear end of the switching engine at Burnside, a short distance west of the Burnside School street crossing.

The accident occurred shortly after seven o'clock standard time. The first person on the scene was Michael Lynch of 478 Park avenue, who lives a short distance from the scene of the accident. When he arrived he found the engineer of the switching engine, Charles Green, of East Hartford, lying critically injured in a pool of hot water beside his cab, from which he had been thrown when the freight engine telescoped his tender and engine from behind.

Lynch pulled the injured engineer from the water and away from the engine and possible danger from a boiler explosion or scalding by steam from the broken feed lines of the engine. He also later called the police and firemen. Engineer Green died at Hartford hospital about an hour after the crash.

Nine cars of the freight were derailed and strewn all over the tracks to the north and south of the right of way. Several of the box cars were loaded and some of the goods were tossed outside the tracks. There were 54 cars in the train.
