





Pope Pius XII conferred the customary palliums today on 20 Archbishops, including those of San Antonio, Texas, Montevideo, Ottawa, and Montreal, in a secret consistory of the College of Cardinals.

(The pallium is a circular band of white wool, with pendants, worn about the neck. The pope alone has the right to confer the pallium. Worn by archbishops, it typines their participation in the supreme pastoral power of the pope.)
