Hurley Picks Dooley as Public Utilities Commissioner; Phelps for Commissioner of Finance and Control; Burke to Keep Public Works Post; Bailey For Revising Statutes.

State Capital, Hartford, May 13.—(P)—Gov. Robert A. Hurley today named his close friend and political adviser, State Democratic Chairman John T. McCarthy, as state motor vehicles commissioner. Simultaneously, the Democratic chief executive announced several other major appointments, among them Vincent P. Dooley of New Haven as public utilities commissioner, William J. Cox of New Haven to succeed himself as highway commissioner, Lewis W. Phelps of Andover as state commissioner of finance and control, George E. Burke to succeed himself as public works commissioner, John Bailey of Hartford as state statute revision commissioner. All of the nominees are Democrats, with the exception of the public utilities nomination, all require confirmation only by the Senate, controlled by Democrats.

Both houses must confirm the nomination of Dooley, New Haven city corporation counsel who would succeed a fellow Iowa Democrat, Edwin L. Taylor for a term ending July 1, 1945.

Bready, 31, Putnam alderman and police commissioner, and Walter Krzemien, 31, of Hartford, were taken into custody here early Monday and placed under \$100,000 bond each.

British Shell Bengasi Base

Cruisers and Destroyers Sweep into Harbor to Hurl High Explosive.

Aboard a Flagship with the British Mediterranean Fleet, May 13.—(P)—A British cruiser-destroyer squadron swept into the harbor of Bengasi, Libya, and hurled 100 tons of high explosive shells into that Axis base last Wednesday night.

Striking this new blow at Nazi-Fascist attempts to maintain their lines in Circasia, eastern Libya, the cruiser Ajax, one of the Admiralty's Admiral Graf Spee, led four destroyers in a shelling of ships anchored alongside the Bengasi mole.

Shattering the targets with incendiary bombs and high explosive shells, the British ships caused only minor damage and the Germans described their own attacks as on a smaller scale than recently.

Report Fires Started
 Informed Germans said fires were started at Benghazi, Tripoli and Benghazi.

These sources said German bombers also attacked the British Mediterranean stronghold of Malta, damaging runways, hangars and workshops at the Luqa airport and scoring hits on wharves, warehouses and ships in the harbor at Valetta.

Say Hess Flight May Alter Course of War; Hitler Talks to Nazis

Berlin, May 13.—(P)—Close upon Rudolf Hess's flight to Scotland—with whom the Nazis called an "hallucination" of German-British peace—the sub-leadership of the Reich met today with Adolf Hitler to discuss details of the meeting for the purpose of determining will for victory.

Hess, Number Three man in the Nazi hierarchy, made his fantasy flight to Scotland because "he felt it was his duty to bring about an understanding between Germany and England with old English acquaintances," the Nazi party announced official today.

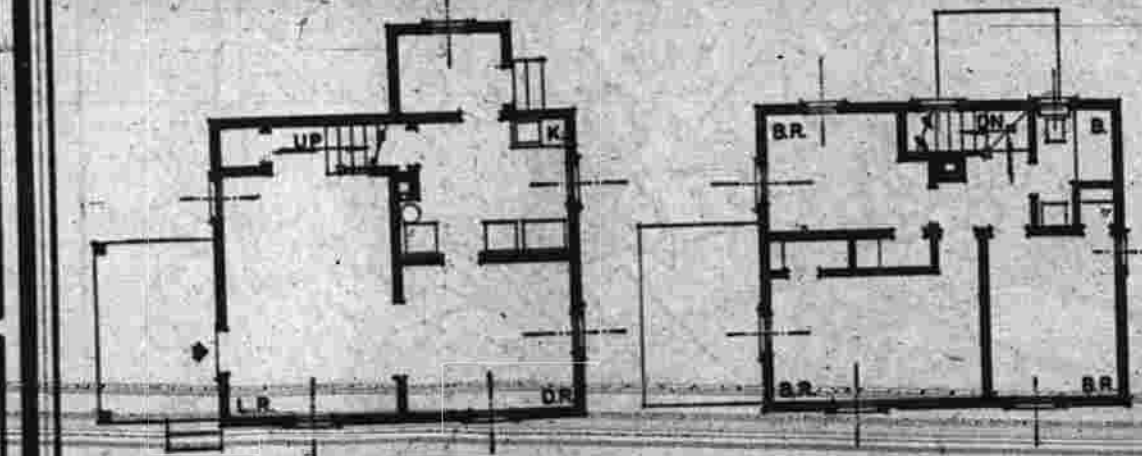
