Foes Developing Every Resource

"The enemies of democracy are developing every hydro-electric resource and every waterway from Norway to the Dardanelles. Are we to allow this continent to be outmatched because short-sighted interests oppose the development of one of our greatest resources?"

Mr. Roosevelt declared he had been advised the project could be built in four years, adding:

"Under emergency pressure it may be completed in less time. I should like to agree with the people who say that the country's danger will be over sooner than that.

New York, June 5.—(P)—Twelve husky Finnish seamen who sailed the bark Killoran out of Rio de Janeiro last summer with a load of grain for England and then disappeared in the South Atlantic have reached their homeland after a year aboard the German raider that sank their vessel and after travel from one prison camp to another in France and Germany.

Advices reaching here from Finland said Captain Lehman and his men spent 41 days aboard the raider which sank three other ships and acquired 150 prisoners, including Dutchmen, Norweglans, Danes, Argentines New Zealsanders, Poles and Englishmen.

Hartford, June 5—The high number of repections at the automobile inspection lanes is due to the fact that cars long begged down on used cars lots are being bought up by reemployed workers for cheap transportation, according to a Motor Vehicles Department bulletin released today.

7,000 Rejections

Used cars not in satisfactory condition are no longer hard for dealers to sell, and account for many of the nearly 70,000 rejections at the lanes so far during the Spring period, the bulletin stated. Many of these were brought to the lanes soon after purchase because their owners wanted to know whether they were in safe condition. 

"The most difficult problem is the determination of how to maintain essential air power without bankrupting the country," Marshall said. "At the present time, we are building for a definite situation. It will be quite a different matter when we are not focused on a particular situation. Still, air power will have to be maintained. That is going to require most expert handling. Air power will depend on the skill with which we arrange for obsolescence."
