

Reich Consulates In United States Ordered to Close

Welles, in Announcing Action; Says It Does Not Imply Break in Diplomatic Relations And Does Not Affect Staff at Washington.

Washington, June 16.—(AP)—The United States today ordered all German consulates closed by July 10 because of activities "inimical to the welfare of this country."

He made the announcement after handing a note to Dr. Wilhelm Frensberg, first secretary of the German embassy, in the absence of Hans Thomsen, chargé d'affaires, who was in New York.

The order requires the closing of the German Library of Information and Travel Bureau and the German Transoceanic News Agency. It calls for removal of all activities connected with the consulates and these agencies.

It has come to the knowledge of this government, the Welles note said, "that agencies of the German Reich in this country, including German consular establishments, have been engaged in activities wholly outside the scope of their legitimate duties.

These activities have been of an improper and unwarranted character. They render the continued presence in the United States of these agencies and consular establishments inimical to the welfare of this country."

This was the first action against German consular establishments in this country, although Italian consulates at Detroit and Newark, N. J., were ordered closed some time ago.

Considered Reprisal The action against the Italian consulates was considered a reprisal for an Italian order requiring the closing of two American consulates in Italy in mid-February.

In another step against Italy, the United States several weeks ago forced the recall of admiral Roberto Lala. Italian Naval attacks in Washington, on the grounds that he was connected with the sabotaging of American merchant ships.

Dutch Reject Japan's 'New Order' Plans

East Indies Governor-General Declares Axis Victory Would Spell Destruction of Nation.

Batavia, Netherlands East Indies, June 16.—(AP)—The governor-general of these Dutch Pacific possessions, speaking in the midst of an economic crisis with Japan, declared today his government would not accept the Japanese "new order for East Asia."

Addressing the opening session of the Legislative People's Council, Governor-General A. V. L. Tjarda van Starkenborgh Stachouwer recalled Japan's entry into the Pacific War and declared an Axis victory "would spell destruction of the kingdom of the Netherlands."

He asserted further that the East Indies government would guard carefully against direct or indirect "dealings" with important raw materials to Germany.

Bloody Battle Slows Down Levant Drive; Admit Kissoué Loss

British Capture Point 10 Miles South of Damascus and Main Bastion of City's Defenses; Also Admit Fall of Djézine, 40 Miles West, to Column Pushing Eastward from Sidon.

Vichy, Unoccupied France, June 16.—(AP)—French military dispatches from Syria admitted today that the British had captured Kissoué, 10 miles south of Damascus, and the main bastion of that city's defenses. The French also admitted the fall of Djézine, 40 miles west of Damascus, to a British column which pushed east from the Mediterranean coast after capturing the ancient port of Sidon.

The British, encountered in "considerable strength" by a French air patrol, were believed to have captured Kissoué. Latest French air reinforcements were said also to have been Naval planes which took part in the offshore fighting covering the French withdrawal north of Sidon.

Two British Warships Damaged in Battle Beirut, Lebanon, June 16.—(AP)—Two British warships have been damaged in a sea and air battle with the French which has been in progress almost continuously for the past 24 hours, military dispatches said today.

Both warships were said to have been destroyed. They were damaged in heavy sea and air attacks during the night. The British warships were reported to have been heavily damaged or sunk and to have come to a standstill with flames spreading aboard.

Bombing Cause Extensive Damage in Cologne and Hainover Areas in Raids London, June 16.—(AP)—Strong forces of British bombers fired industrial targets in western Germany and caused extensive damage in the Cologne and Hannover areas last night, the Air Ministry said today.

Bomb hits were reported on three German supply ships and on a German E-boat (torpedo boat) in daylight operations yesterday. In days the third consecutive night of raiding over the industrial areas of northern and western Germany.

British Launch Drive Along Libya Frontier

Advances with Surrender of Italian General And 2,000 Troops.

Cairo, Egypt, June 16.—(AP)—The British have launched a slashing offensive against the Germans and Italians along the Egyptian-Libyan frontier and the mop-up of East Africa has advanced a major step with the surrender of an Italian general and 2,000 troops in the Japanese-occupied Middle East command.

Announced today, plunging across the Libyan border, where the Stuez-bound Axis drive stalled two months ago, Imperial forces were declared to have destroyed 12 Axis vehicles in the Gambia area, just across the frontier west of Bardia.

The operation is continuing, the British said, and is aimed at Axis positions south and southeast of the border outpost of Sallum in the eastern Mediterranean.

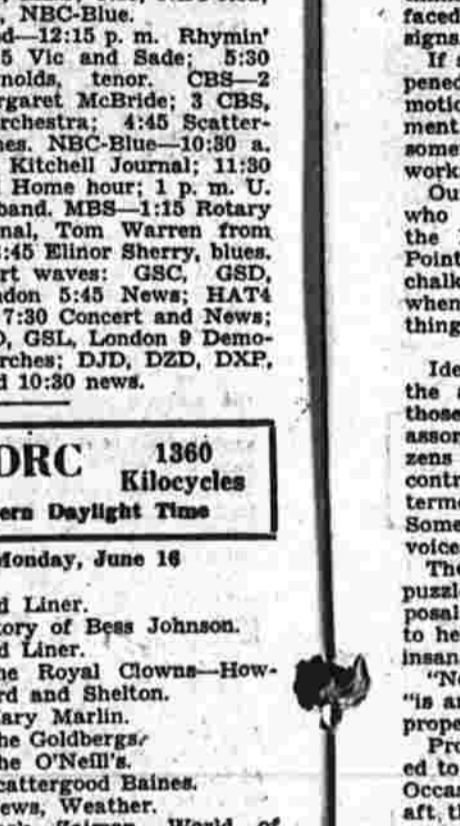
