Washington, June 17.—(A)
—Sumner Welles, undersecretary of state, said today the government's basic charges missing survivors at Capetown yesterday. 





Danzig's Free City Status Short-Lived TRONIC is this Danzig stamp, issued just before the Nazi occu-The stamp depicts the signing of the treaty between Danzig and Sweden, thus ending an early 18th century war in which Sweden found herself engaged with Po-land and Denmark. The stamp was issued in 1939 to commemorate the reunion of Danzig and Prussia in 1914 and served as a harbinger of events which were to follow swiftly.

Danzig became a free city under the terms of the Treaty of Versailles. Previously it had been the capital of East Prussia, but when World War I ended, Poland insisted on getting Danzig as an outlet to the sea.

Hesitant to grant this request in view of Danzig's 96 per cent German population, the peace conference compromised by setting up Danzig and some surrounding territory as free, to be administered by the League of Nations.
