Germans Smash Through Red Defenses; Massed Soviet Units Halt Nazi Advance

Roosevelt Urges Defense Housing Fund Be Doubled

Proposes Congress Authorize Spending Additional \$300,000,000 For Purpose; Suggests Speedy Consideration In View of Urgency.

Washington, June 26.—(AP)—President Roosevelt proposed today that Congress authorize spending of an additional \$300,000,000 on defense housing. This would double the amount approved last October. In a special message to the legislators, Mr. Roosevelt suggested early consideration of his recommendation "in view of the urgency of this matter."

"Data have been presented to me," he said, "which indicate the possibility that the government should be prepared to undertake the construction of at least 150,000 additional defense homes between now and July 1, 1942. It is thought best, however, to limit the additional program to \$300,000,000 at this time, which will permit the construction of approximately 75,000 homes to fill the most urgent present needs."

Of the original \$300,000,000 authorized for defense housing, \$200,000,000 has been made to its full extent and practically all the money allocated to projects. The president emphasized that without housing for workers, industries producing ships and planes and other defense materials cannot function to full capacity.

Effect Not Fully Felt. He admitted the difficulty of predicting housing needs accurately and said the effect of the defense program had not yet registered fully on the housing market. In some instances, Mr. Roosevelt said, increased sub-contracting and curtailment of some types of production for civilian use will reduce to some extent the need for new housing. But in many cases erection of new plants or expansion of existing ones, the president said, will take place in areas not affected by these factors.

Positions captured yesterday in the region of Merjayoun, southern Syria, are being consolidated, the daily communiqué said, while British land guns and guns of the British fleet off the coast are operating in supporting the British drive toward Beirut.
