Ecuador Charges Peru Is at Fault In Border Battle

Government Tells Army To Hold Southern Frontier; Political and Military Aggression Is Charged; Crowds Parade Streets of Quito.

Quito, Ecuador, July 7.—A two-day flareup of order fighting and bombing raids between Peru and Ecuador was reported in frontier bulletins today. The government here said there had been no fighting since last night, and military officials said Ecuador would send no reinforcements because frontier detachments and local reserves could handle the situation. A medical detachment will be sent to care for the wounded.

Steadily-mounting reports from the south told of two sporadic garrison battles, artillery shelling of frontier towns by Peruvian troops, and Peruvian bomb raids on Ecuador's military outposts.

After a hurried session of President Arroyo de Rio's cabinet last night, the Ministry of Defense issued a communique blaming the outbreak on a penetration of Ecuadorian territory by Peruvian soldiers and civilians, and declaring that the Peruvian army had been ordered to advance to the frontier.

Hitler's Legions Jockeying for Positions With Soviet Troops for What Berlin Hints Will Be Another Vast Battle to Smash Soviet Resistance; Bulletin Points to More Gains.

Berlin, July 7.—The Germans asserted today they had broken the Stalin Line, Soviet Russia's main fortifications against invasion from the west, and the Axis forces captured Cernauti, capital of Bucovina. The claim that the Stalin line, stretching along western Russia from the Black Sea to the Gulf of Finland, had been broken was made by DNE (German news agency), and it followed German reports that Adolf Hitler's legions were jockeying for positions with Soviet Elite troops for what Berlin hinted possibly would be another vast battle two months earlier than it usually is.

The high command's war report, however, did not mention the Stalin line. The war bulletin from Hitler's headquarters focused attention upon reported gains in Bessarabia and Bessarabia, provinces wrested from Romania by the Soviet union a year ago.

Suggest Cuts In Town Cost

Selectmen to Inquire on Charity Expenses Especially This Year.

Sweeping cuts in several town appropriations which have gradually crept upward with no apparent benefit during the past few years are to be sought when the Board of Selectmen and town meeting act on money matters for the coming fiscal year, it was learned today. In addition to direct reductions, more returns for money spent may be asked of some departments.

Selectmen are reportedly to be asked several "well-informed" questions regarding charity costs soon—that is, questions to which the questioners already claim to know the answers while apparently the selectmen do not. Charity Two High There is evidence, it is claimed

by those who have been compiling figures, that the \$100,000 charity item is altogether too high for another year, and that any attempt to "trim" the budget for this year is being privately studied in the \$100,000 vicinity is to be stopped. A budget as low as half that sum is being privately worked out. Comment has been heard to the effect that the average private citizen here, who about as much concerning the charity problem as do the selectmen.
