The dispersed forces were declared to have been concealed in an artillery hide-out made possible by the vastness of the territory covered by the army.

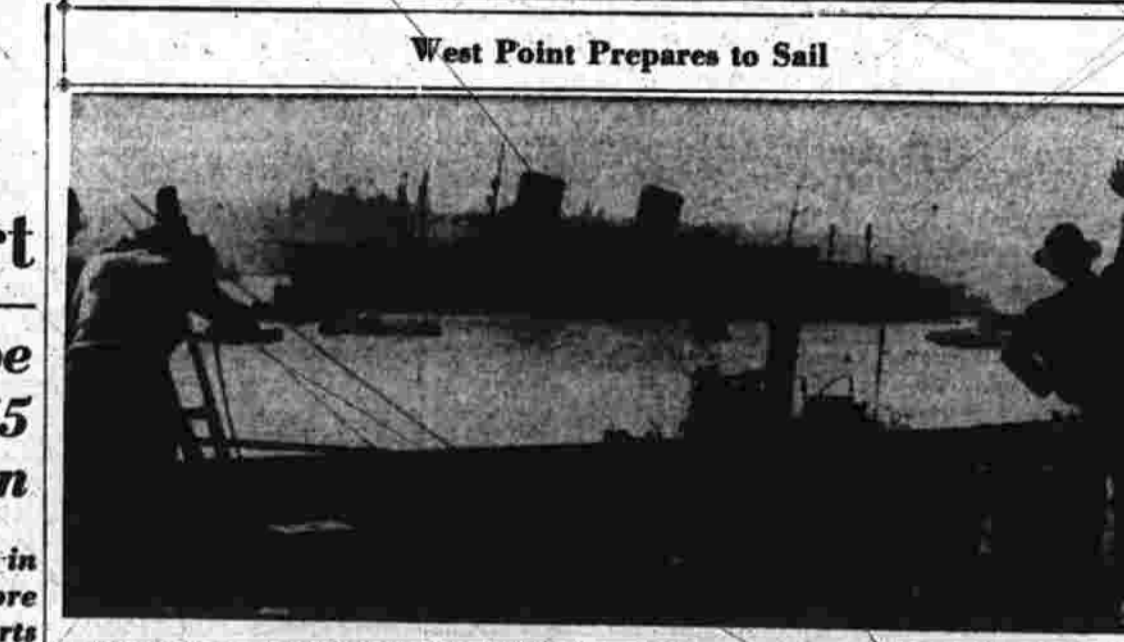
