Production is primitive and not intensive. There are approximately 95 million acres of arable land, of which only 2,300,000 are sown.

The fruit industry has developed, especially in the region around Valparaiso. Fresh, dried, canned and preserved fruits are exported. Peaches, pears, plums, apprious and melons are grown. Apples, the most important crop in the south, strawberries, responsives, loganberries and currants flourish.
