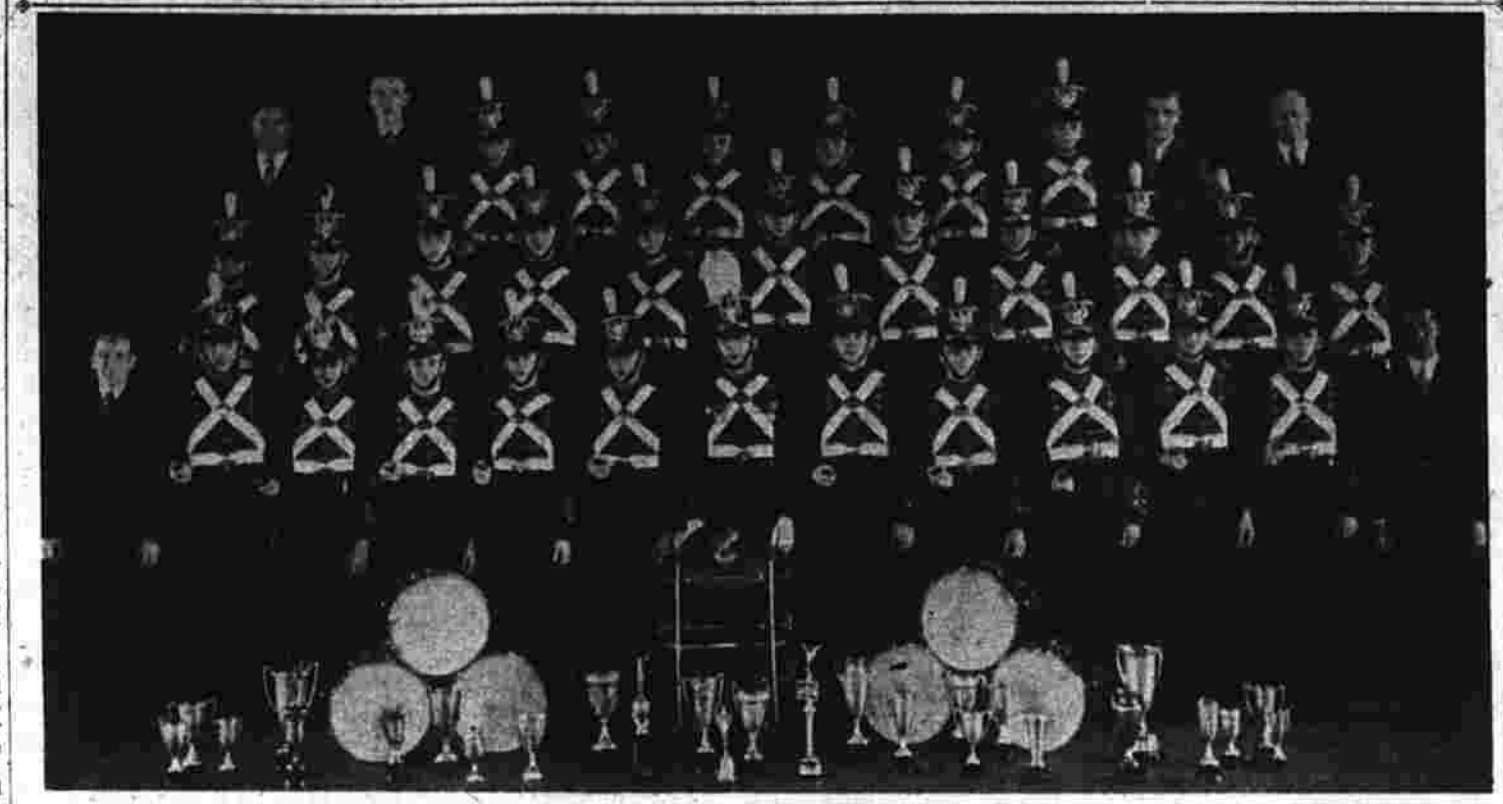

Firms Increase Capital Stock

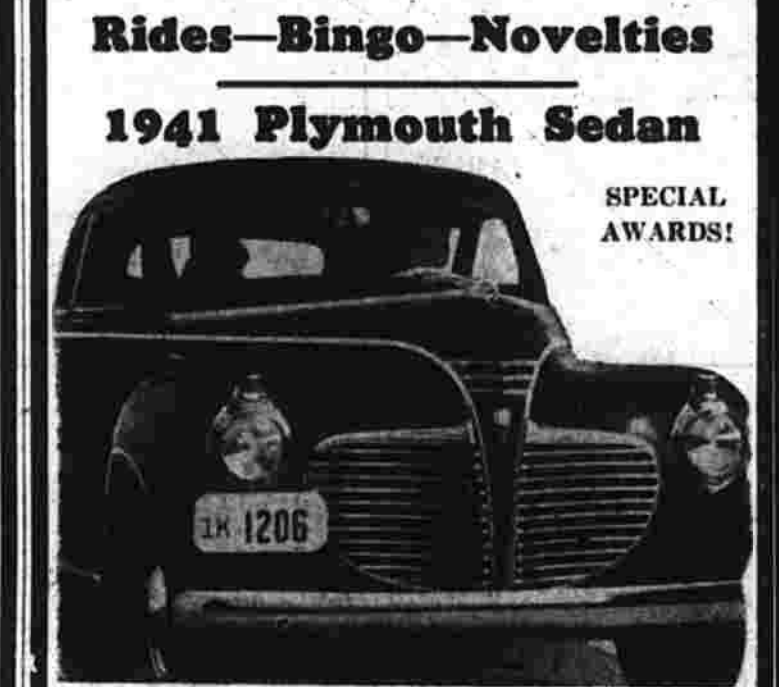
