### Home Taxpayers?

7,000,000 New Taxpayers? The Senate Finance Committee voted to cut income tax exemptions from \$2,000 to \$1,500 for married persons and from \$800 to \$750 for single persons. It was estimated this would increase government revenues by \$300,000,000 a year.

The House has passed a bill increasing taxes \$3,250,000,000. It eliminated a compulsory joint-return clause and the Senate group is trying to make up for the revenue thus lost.

Senator George (D-Ga.), chairman of the committee, said the cut in exemptions would add 7,000,000 persons to the tax rolls but that they would pay only one-sixth of the income tax.

A single man with \$2,000 net income (after deductions) would pay \$17 under the Senate bill, \$10 under the House bill. He pays \$44 now. A married man with two children and the same income would continue to be exempt under both bills.

With still more money to be raised, the Senate committee rejected a proposal for a general manufacturing tax.
