

Suggests New Draft Exam

Federal Health Expert Declares Less Men Would Be Rejected.

New Haven, Sept. 17.—(AP)—Hopes for physical rehabilitation of a substantial proportion of rejected army draftees may lie in the adoption of a program similar to that recently recommended by examining physicians of the National Youth Administration. Dr. George St. J. Perrot, chief of the division of public health methods of the U. S. Public Health Service, told Connecticut physicians today.

Dr. Perrot, of Bethesda, Md., reported to the Seventeenth Clinical Congress of the Connecticut State Medical Society that NYA examiners had found, for example, that only 10 per cent of all young men examined were rejected because of defective teeth. Eight and three tenths per cent of all examined are being rejected for this cause, four times the rate reported added, however, that only 18 per cent had been declared unfit for any military service.

The remaining 15 per cent, claimed as fit for limited service, suffered from defects, which Perrot felt were largely remedial.

In most instances, he said, "The correction of defects among our young men," he said

Follow Odd Dining Hours

Defense Workers Upset Restaurant Routine; Eat at Various Times.

Many people living in Manchester work such unusual hours that some are having breakfast when others are having dinner and still a third group may be sitting in front of the local restaurants. The Murphy restaurant on Main street is one of the places that has found this to be true and in order to take care of the increased business demands they have started making several changes in the restaurant. The booths have all been removed from the center of the room and tables and chairs to the room and orders have been placed for new tables and chairs to increase the seating capacity by 24 percent.

Nearly all of the increase in business and service has been caused by defense workers who have hired rooms in Manchester. Some start work at 3:30 in the afternoon. They are at the restaurant about 2:30 in the afternoon ordering lunch and eggs or some other quick breakfast item while others, who are quitting work about 10:30 and frantically or a leaf to eat a little lunch before taking exercise or going to bed while others are sitting dinner and ordering steaks. What is true at this hour in the afternoon is also true at midnight and again early in the morning.

Not all who are eating in restaurants in Manchester are making their homes in town. Some are living in summer cottages east of Manchester and are getting their meals in Manchester.

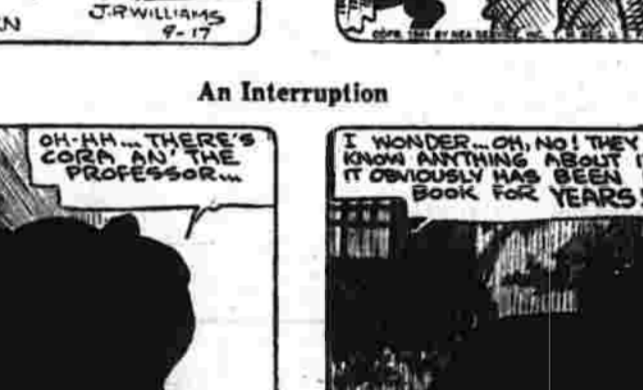
