President Roosevelt's hand in another effective foreign policy and it came after the tense House heard a dramatic last-minute appeal from the president.

By its vote the House joined the Senate in broadening the original House ship-arming bill to end all neutral restrictions on the movement of vessels flying the American flag.

Nevertheless, there was abundant evidence that the technicality of the bill, three days would prevent the administration from putting the measure into effect.

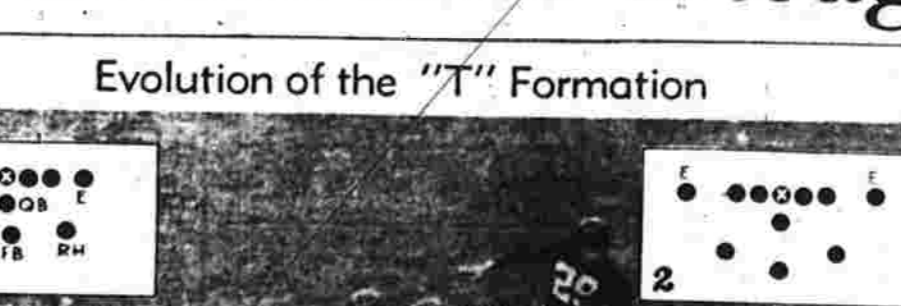

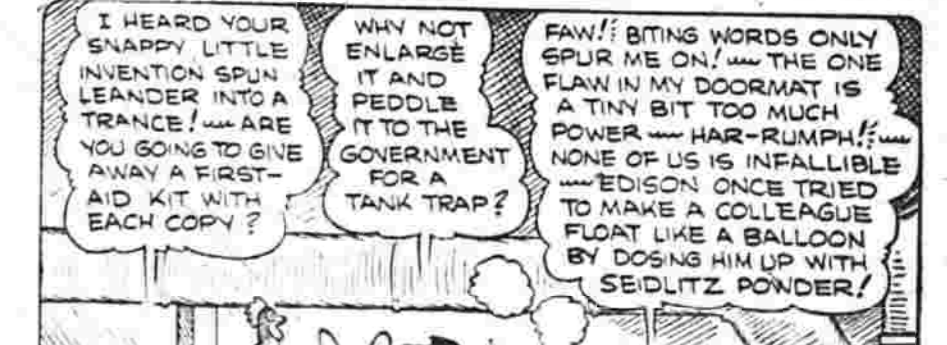
