Cairo, Dec. 2.—(AP)—The rout of the Germans from the British desert by the British and Red Army cavalrymen and guerrillas is adding to the German confusion in the Donets basin and southwestern area; Put to Flight in Deep Snow Drifted by Biting Wind Near Stalingorsk.

Cairo, Egypt, Dec. 2.—(AP)—The Germans have succeeded in joining their two Panzer divisions in the fighting in the Libyan desert by cutting through the British corridor to Tobruk. The British have lost Rezegh and Bir El Hamed in the battle, the British said today.
