Japs Widen Attacks In Western Pacific; Landing in Sarawak

Throw Land, Sea and Air Forces into Spreading Offensive Around South China Sea; Evidently Aiming for Quick Knockout of British and Dutch Strongholds in Area.

Singapore, Dec. 17.—(AP)—Japanese forces have landed in Sarawak, a British area on the northwest coast of Borneo, it was announced today as the Japanese threw their land, sea and air forces into a spreading offensive around the South China Sea.

Germans in Some Sections Retreat Without Fighting

Moscow, Dec. 17.—(AP)—On the whole Russian front, from far north to long-besieged Leningrad to the Black Sea, the Red Army was reported on the offensive today, taking hundreds of towns and villages in one sector after another in a mighty winter sweep against the Germans who were said to be retreating in some instances to have run without a fight.

Plan to Unify War Program

Britain Has Not Asked Russia to Declare War on Japan Yet.

London, Dec. 17.—(AP)—Government spokesmen told the House of Commons today that all steps had been taken to coordinate British, American and Allied war plans in accord with President Roosevelt's call for "world scale strategy" but that Britain had not asked Russia to declare war on Japan.

China Full Ally Law said that China had full legal status as a British ally, foreclosing a question long for forth-coming secret debate on the war situation, and the creation of a unified Allied war strategy in the empire.

# AIR RAID WARNING

- The Town of Manchester will have a trial of its Air Raid Warning Signal System on Friday, December 19th at 2:30 P. M.
- The purposes in having the trial is to see how widely the alarm system will be heard. The Alarm, Signal will be a series of short blasts on the fire whistles, supplemented by a series of blasts on the sirens and klaxons of the fire and police departments.
- Last week we announced a different alarm system which was given us by the State Defense Council. The State has now announced the alarm system in Paragraph 2 (above) as the uniform warning signal throughout the State. This conforms with the warning signal to be used throughout the whole United States.
- When the alarm sounds, each school in town will hold an Air Raid drill.
- The trial is being carried out in the interest of the safety and welfare of the people of the Town and the public is requested to cooperate. The Air Raid Precautions Committee is therefore asking all drivers of motor vehicles to park at the curb so that the streets may be cleared for Police, Fire, Ambulance and Rescue Squad apparatus. As this is primarily a test of alarms and communications, pedestrians and occupants of cars are not requested to seek shelter in buildings.
- Precinct Wardens will immediately report to their posts and check in by telephone to the Control Center.
- Chiefs of the following services will report to the Control Center:
  - Ambulance Unit
  - Demolition and Rescue Squad
  - Communications and Alarms
  - De-contamination Squad
  - Medical and First Aid Unit

As this is the first trial and is primarily a trial of alarms and communications, it will not be necessary to assemble apparatus ready for dispatching, such as Ambulance, Rescue Squads, Medical and First Aid Services.

Representatives of the Public Utility Companies will report to the Report Center

The "All Clear" will sound at 2:35 P. M. The "All Clear" signal will be a long blast of the whistles, sirens and klaxons.

Cooperation from the citizens of the Town in reporting failures to hear the alarm is requested. If the alarm is not heard by you, please mail a post card to Mrs. Thomas Martin, 110 Forest Street, Manchester, Conn., stating
