Tokyo, Jan. 13.—(Official Broadcast Recorded by AP)—Domei news agency today broadcast the following war roundup: "While Anglo-American sources repeatedly voiced extreme pessimism regarding Singapore's ability to withstand Japanese attack without further reinforcement, Japanese forces were continuing their sweeping advance down the Malaya peninsula with a vanguard of the Japanese tank corps pushing into Negri Sembilan state this afternoon.

11 Japanese Batteries Silenced and Others Are Forced to Fall Back Under Relentless Shelling by Guns in Defense Positions on Bataan Peninsula; Japanese Losses Are Heavy.

Washington, Jan. 13.—(AP)—American and Filipino artillery batteries have "proved definitely superior" to the Japanese, the War Department said today in announcing that columns of enemy tanks, other armored units and infantry had been "shattered and dispersed" in a 24-hour battle. Eleven Japanese batteries were silenced and others were forced to fall back under relentless shelling by the American-Filipino guns in defense positions on the Bataan peninsula west of Manila Bay, the department said.
