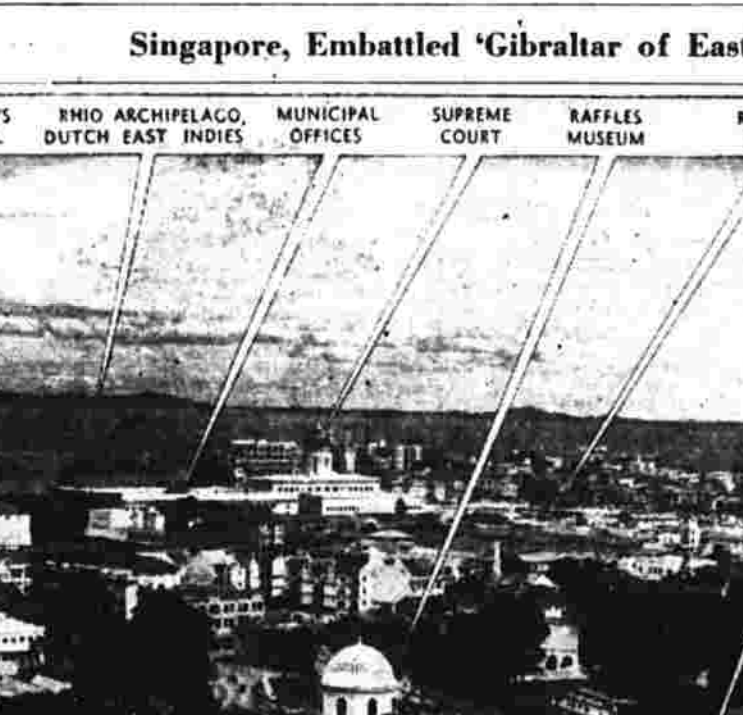

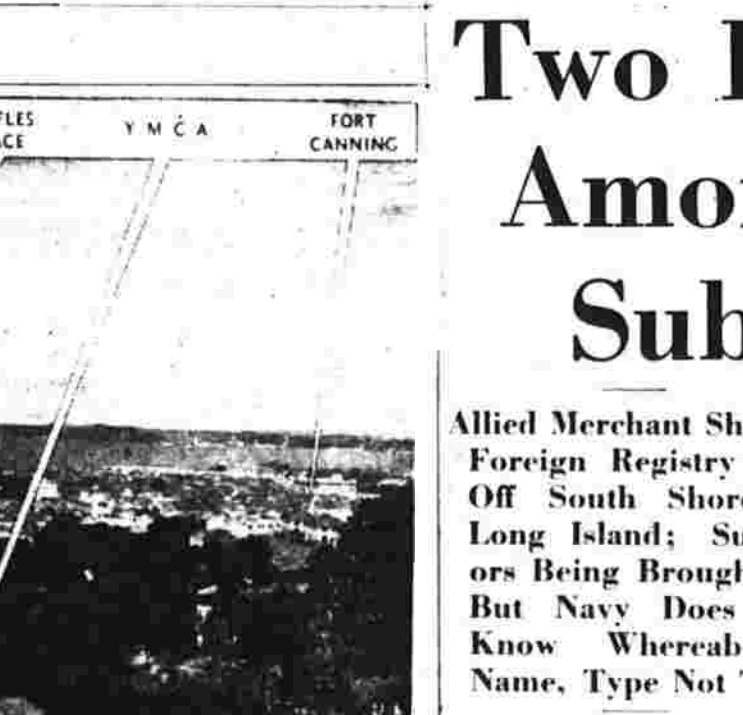

Synthetic Rubber Plants Are Rushed to Completion

By Paul Gessner and John Buckley
New York, Jan. 16.—Never again, the experts say, will the United States be dependent on foreign sources for its essential rubber supply.

The switch to synthetic from native rubber planned this week is one of the far-reaching changes in the national economy due to the attack on us when World War Number Two is over.

Announcements that the government will build in cooperation with private industry a string of synthetic rubber plants to increase production to 400,000 tons annually come not a minute too early.

The United States in a normal year uses about 600,000 tons of rubber annually.

The British and Japanese in Malaya are making a shambles of the vast rubber plantations there from which we used to get up to 900,000 tons of rubber a year.

Military analysts believe that should the Japanese be driven out of Malaya at a future date, they would be unable to produce the quantity of any remaining rubber trees and plantations.



BUY UNITED STATES SAVINGS BONDS AND STAMPS

The new factories to increase synthetic rubber production will cost about \$400,000,000, and at that rate the synthetic product will cost about 30 cents a pound, compared with a shade over 20 cents for the native product.

But the cry today is not the rubber man's cry, that as the industry becomes more experienced it will be able to produce a broad scale, new methods and processes which will be developed which will cheapen the cost per pound, that held true in the case of the many other synthetic products.

Rubber tires are required for the lining of gasoline tanks on warplanes to make the tanks bullet-proof.

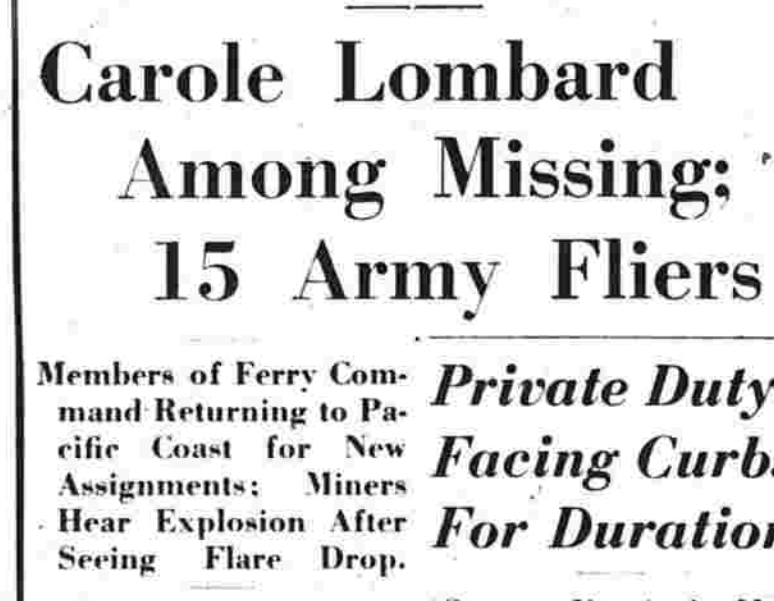
