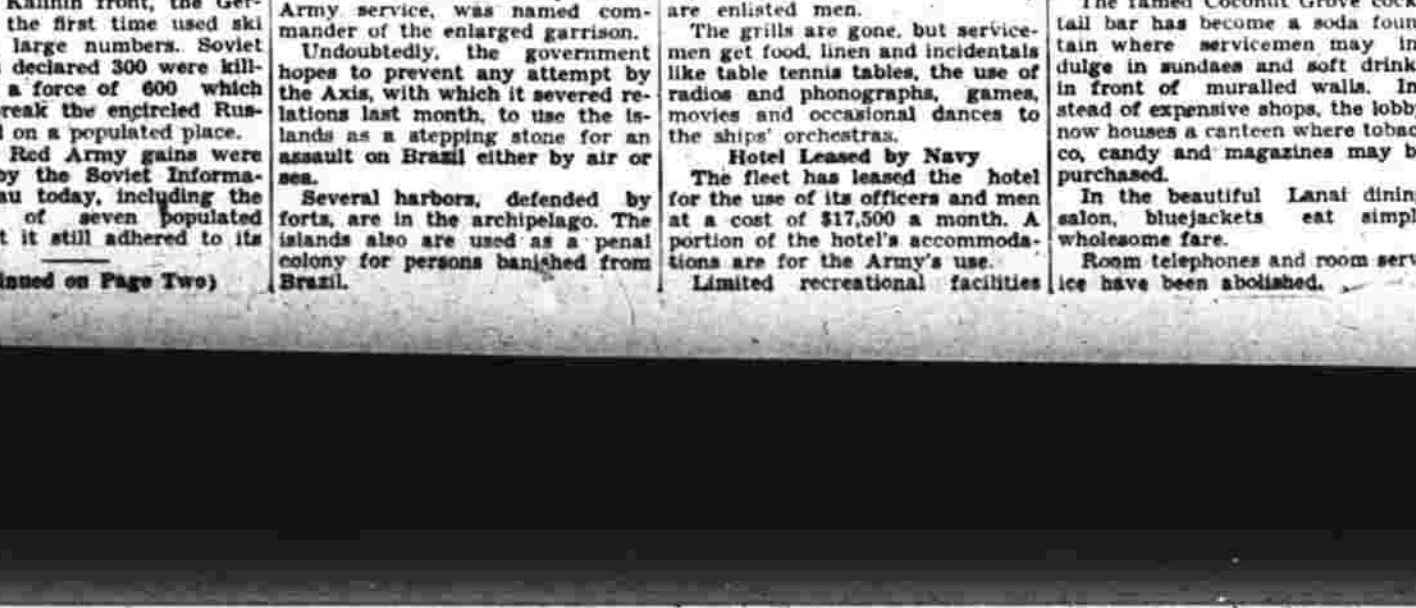

Chinese Generalissimo Makes Visit to India

Specific Mission of Chiang Kai-Shek to Confer with Indian Officials Not Disclosed.

New Delhi, Feb. 10.—(AP)—Fuller collaboration in the United Nations' cause by the 300,000,000 inhabitants of China and India—one-third of the earth's population—was the specific mission of Chinese Generalissimo Chiang Kai-Shek.

What specific mission brought Chiang's war leader and the United Nations' supreme commander in the China war theater here with him to confer with Indian officials was not disclosed.

Lord Malhotra, viceroy of India, however, said the meeting set the seal on the comradeship between India and China, who had been fighting the Japanese since 1937.

Japan would learn to her sorrow that it had no ally in the East.

Apart from his key post in the United Nations, Chiang Kai-Shek has tremendous stakes in the defense of Burma and India against the Japanese invader.

Weeds and Wild Plants Seen Preventing Hunger

Tunkege, Ala., Feb. 10.—(AP)—Dr. George C. Duke, Jr., a Washington, D. C., botanist, says that wild plants and weeds are not only a food but medicine.

Dr. Duke doesn't depend on chemical analysis alone to determine the eating qualities of wild plants. He is an expert at seeing the value of plants from their appearance, smell and other "cues."

These uncultivated plants often prove more nutritious than their domesticated garden cousins, says the expert Negro scientist.

He has prepared many recipes for cooking wild plants which he believes are available in the event war-time economy forced a shortage of canned and green vegetables.

Dr. Duke's recipe for a soup grass pie is made from ordinary sorrel grass weeds, known as "wild spinach."

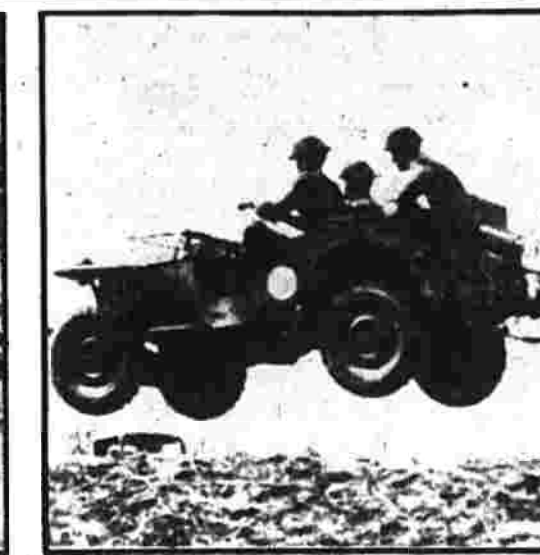
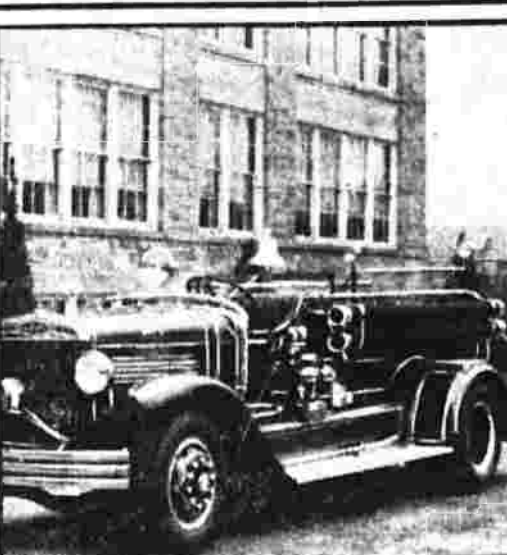
