More Local Property For Housing Projects

Government Gets an Option on 37 Additional Acres Here; To Build About 175 Dwellings.

In order to carry out the plan for the erection of 175 houses in the western part of the town, the Federal Housing Administration has secured an option on 37 more acres of land in addition to the 38 acres secured by option from Mrs. Mary Johnson, making a total of 75 acres.

James J. Noon, local real estate agent, acting for the government, has taken an option on 37 acres of land owned by Mrs. Harry E. Seaman on Hartford road which will make possible the extension of road from Hartford road west to Center street through to Hartford road. Two acres from Henry J. Demsey, upon the Bunce family, located to the rear of the houses known as the "Bunce house" on Center street, just west of Foley street.

Under these options the government now has land from near the site of the former Seaman road west to within a few feet of the Brook on Hartford road. The land eventually will be used by the government for the erection of 175 houses. These will be of two and one-half family type and will be located at a low price. The tract is located within 10 minutes of the state defense factories in West Hartford.
