Heavy Guns Again Firing at Bataan; Forts Under Fire

Japanese Entrenching in Some Sections of Peninsula; Nipponese War Planes Active; Siege Guns Inflict No Material Damage

Washington, Feb. 14.—(AP)—Heavy artillery duelling on the Bataan peninsula in the Philippines and resumption of Japanese siege firing on the Corregidor fortifications were reported today by the War Department.

Operations in Bataan during the past twenty-four hours included heavy artillery duelling, aggressive infantry skirmishes, in some sections of the peninsula, and Japanese war planes were active.

Enemy artillery fire from the Cavite shore was again directed against our major defenses. No material damage resulted.

The enemy was active in the air on all parts of our front. "There is nothing to report from other areas."

4. NOW TAKE YOUR NEW TIRE APPLICATION to your District Registrar Board Office (your inspector will direct you). Each board sits regularly to review all tire applications, and to determine who, under the present regulations, is eligible for new tires. If you are wondering why the rigid restrictions exist, note that 98 percent of our rubber comes from the war area around Singapore. There's less than one year's normal supply in the whole country!

5. HELP KEEP OUR FLAG FLYING! Help win this war! We've got to "rebuild our family driving." We've got to "redeem our tires." We've got to stay under 40 miles an hour. And when our present tires are worn down, the great majority of us have got to depend on retreads.
