War Conditions to Prevail from 7:30 Until 8:30 in All the Areas of the Town.

Manchester's second air-raid warning night will be held tomorrow evening beginning at 7:30 for one hour, until 8:30. All divisions of the Manchester Air Raid Protection Committee and allied units will be alerted at the receipt of the signal at 7:30.

"As a test, simulated bombings will occur in 24 different localities in Manchester. The Hartford Center will give the 'yellow' 'blue' and the 'red' warning signals of the approach of the bombers over Manchester. On receipt of the 'red' signal the air-raid alarm will be sounded. At the sound of the alarm, which will be given on all available horns and sirens, the wardens will report to their posts and first aid messengers, messengers and sector and post wardens will report to their posts.

Japan Claims Destroyer Is Bombs Victim
