Cut Is Ordered **Public Airports** Would Be Aided

Washington, April 28.—(P)—
The Senate received from President Roosevelt today a request that \$203,451,885 be appropriated for a huge civilian aviation improvement program, including construction and repairs at hundreds of public sirports over the country.

The money would be used by the Civil Aeronautics Administration during the fiscal year beginning July 1 for projects of military value, according to a letter from the Budget Bureau to the president.

Largest single item proposed was \$199,740,000 for continuation of the CAA program of construction, improvement and repair of public sirports and other public landing areas in the United States and territories.
