

Seeking More Tank Cars

The coordination office now is seeking 14,000 additional rall tank cars in order to raise the daily delivery of oil to the east by rall o 800,000 barrels. The railroads now are using approximately 45,000 tank cars to transport around 600,000 barrels daily eastward.

Davies explained it was the normal practice in the middle west to operate tank cars on short hauls, distributing products over areas surrounding refineries and pipe line terminals. While many of these cars now are being taken out of this service, it has been possible thus far to substitute trucks without any disruption of short haul movement of supplies.

Referring to the situation on the gulf coast, the deputy coordinator explained that curtailment had not been necessary there because that area has a surplus of supply due to the lack of ocean tankers to move crude oil and products to the eastern seaboard. In other words, he said, the problem in that section is not one of curtailing consumption locally, but of developing the means for transporting supplies eastward.
