Hartford Becomes Center of FBI Probe of Russian Revolutionists

Hartford, May 11—(AP)—FBI agents today removed a truckload of evidence to Hartford, center of the nationwide investigation of the Russian National Revolutionary Party.

It was learned that no arrests have been made as yet of the party's so-called "Führer," Anastase A. Vonnatsky, but thousands of documents were seized at his Thompson son estate, headquarters of the organization.

Included in the truckload of material was Vonnatsky's elaborate wardrobe of Fascist uniforms.

It is also understood that agents are checking Vonnatsky's file at the Immigration office in the Hartford Federal building concerning his maturation in 1929. He was born in Russia and fled following the revolution.

Married As Helewas In 1922, when 22 years old, he married a Chicago actress, Mrs. Marian E. Keam Stephens, then 45, who lives with him in Thompson.

Doubt that the evidence seized in the week-end raid at Thompson can be assembled in time for presentation to a Grand Jury here tomorrow was expressed in view of the volume of material taken.

Translators were here today to translate hundreds of documents taken from the Russian. The task may take several days.

Meanwhile, the Federal jury is not needed to consider the evidence but will be called for cases presented by U. S. Atty. Robert P. Butler at the opening of the regular May term of U. S. District Court here tomorrow.

Vonnatsky arrived at his Thompson estate from a trip during the week-end to find Federal agents already there armed with a search warrant. He told report-
