"They devoted themselves to superhuman skill and energy to the chemistry of master and obedient laborer, and to their own overwhelming passion—the lust for power. Like Faust, the supreme creation of Germany's greatest thinker, the nation devoted itself to itself with the price of darkness to gain the desired end."

Even before Hitler, Mr. Datta developed the German nation as a despotic, unapproachable aggressive policy toward other European states that has drenched the world in blood for nearly a century.

"This grim design, never yielding to the luller ways of peace and to the enlightenment of civilization, has deeply permeated the German way of life. The guilt of this plot has steadily controlled German mental processes both in public and in private life. It has been the heart of the nation to think in terms of war, preparing for the inevitable day of 'Der Tag.'"

Mr. Datta has short patience with the idea that post-war events in Europe drove Germany into the arms of Hitler. The German people themselves, he states, were responsible for the "moral collapse" of their nation.

Ideas for Solving Rubber Problem Flooding Capital
