Good Neighbor Policy Triumphs in Mexico

Brings Decision to Declare War on Axis Powers in Full Alliance with United States.

Mexico City, May 27.—(Wide World)—A nine-year triumph of the good neighbor policy in the face of important economic and political differences brought Mexico to the decision to declare war on the Axis powers in full alliance with the United States.

Mexican army and navy leaders had fought bloody battles; the average Mexican remembered that his was the only Latin American country on which the U. S. had declared war during the recent celebration of the death of Mexican cadets defending Vera Cruz in 1914, and the status of the "heroic children" killed in the battle of Chapultepec in 1914.

But the United States kept these memories alive.

Respectful, but suspicious, that was the situation when President Roosevelt, in beginning his first term, delineated the good neighbor policy. Mexico was not a friend, but still suspicious.

The first impression made by the appointment of Joseph Daniels as ambassador to Mexico was unfortunate. Daniels had been secretary of the Navy when the United States was occupied by U. S. forces in 1914.

But from the moment that Mr. Daniels presented his credentials in 1933, that impression was changed. The country's southern man in society and business alike knew Daniels, Mexicans began to feel that perhaps the United States was not so imperialistic after all.

His feeling deepened when the Mexican appropriation of foreign properties in 1938 put a heavy strain on Mexico-U. S. relations.

American News Moderate

The U. S. notes in the matter of the moderate Daniels according to Mexicans in office at the time, presented them with additional representations and obtained from criticism of the Mexican action. Even when the decision between the two countries was most difficult, he remained cordial, honest and fair.

Highly or wrongly, the average Mexican came to the opinion that the United States, during the ensuing negotiations, decided the Mexican position was justified.

Settlement of the oil dispute was formalized in November, 1941, a series of U. S.-Mexican agreements which provided for the oil industry's stabilization and highway financing.

When the presidential elections were held in 1940, most Mexicans thought that the defeated candidate, Gen. Jose Andres Almazan, had United States backing. But when the U. S. government sent Henry A. Wallace to the inauguration of President Avila Camacho, the country took that as proof the U. S. never had any intention of intervening.

While becoming convinced that the good neighbor policy meant what it said, Mexicans were getting to know the people from above the Rio Grande better.

The opening of the Pan-American highway in 1937 brought the face of the new tourist crowds—folks who spent pesos as if they were quarters. They went to the tourists, but they are as big as dollars to Mexicans.

English classes in Mexican schools increased. North American history and civics became compulsory.

Then, by the time the first Pearl Harbor extra was on the streets last Dec. 7, Mexicans were ready for an even stronger stand than the one President Avila Camacho took. He said then: "Our role in this war is in the defense of our factories and mines, at least for the time being."

Politically, Mexico took early leadership among the Latin American states breaking diplomatic and other relations with the Axis.

Became Yahuah, Mexico quickly became an active and valuable partner in the Allied armaments drive.

Thousands of tons of strategic metals, their other sources lost to the United States in the Pacific conflict, poured into Mexico from U. S. factories from the south.

Polonium, mercury, manganese, vanadium, as well as strategic metals, copper, lead and zinc. And Mexico can produce at least 30,000,000 barrels of oil a year for the Axis.

There was almost no Mexican disillusionment on the contrary, the powerful leftist trade union had shown their weight early on the side of greater Mexican participation in the war, and especially since the German attack on Soviet Russia, strikes were called; production went up.

In April, Mexico signed an agreement with the United States for decidedly increased metal output.

Joint Defense Plan

After Pearl Harbor, Army officers of the two countries met to plan the joint defense of the North American coast. U. S. The Mexican Pacific coast defense setup was completed—this was the Pan American back door—and former President Carrasco, a top general, was placed in command. Improvements in the Mexican Army were completed.

U. S. soldiers crossed the border into Mexico, but this time they were invited. Mexican military establishments.

Generalissimo Cárdenas, who had been in power since 1934, on the route to Mexico City, but this time they were invited.

Urges American Attitude Change

Allentown, Pa., May 27.—(AP)—There is to be peace in the future, Mrs. Franklin D. Roosevelt said last night, a world economy must be developed "to make it possible for people all over the world to work and live in decency."

"That is a tall order, not easy to achieve, and one that will cost some people a great deal," she told a woman's day audience at Muhlenberg College's bicentennial celebration.

She suggested also "a change in our attitude toward other races of the world" and urged women to become leaders in the "eradication of prejudices."

Hollywood, May 27.—We used to look upon the "teen age" as the crossover of a girl's life. Now, however, the awkward age when a girl's whole personality and appearance undergo a metamorphosis.

Whether it is the trend of the day or whether Shirley is just fortunate, I have not found this period a real problem in any sense. Shirley recently celebrated her 14th birthday, and while I naturally see her development, mentally and physically, she seems to have escaped this so-called awkward age completely.

Thanks for Herself

It has been most interesting to follow her development, the changes in her mental and physical, her entire conception of life. She thinks for herself now and the ordinary girl her age has pretty definite ideas of her own.

I have not tried any magic formula in my associations with her. There has been no necessity, for she is no problem child, nor is she a prodigy.

At school she is an average student and going to a private school for girls, she may enjoy a little higher standard of education but not a great deal more than any youngster in public school. She reads considerably more from the radio, keeping up with the news and, more especially, with musical knowledge, for she loves symphonic as well as modern music.

10 Monthly Allowance

Both her dad and I have always tried to make her realize the value of things and I feel that she does. We give her an allowance of about \$10 a month. Out of this she pays dues in the various groups to which she belongs, keeps her book appreciation at school, and buys incidental like soft drinks and ice cream.

We have never indulged her, and consequently she appreciates whatever we do for her.

She has become a little more clothes-conscious since she reached the "teen age," and I believe exhibits pretty good judgment in her selection of the likes to pick out ready-made dresses, and I have seen her get a bigger shirt out of an outfit costing \$13 or \$15 than she would with a tailored creation. Her sense of style is good, but she actually likes most any color.

Radio While Studying

I can appreciate what her every mother encounters with her child home work. Shirley never do algebra accompanied by some mysterious program on the radio—and the more mysterious the better. I don't know how she can concentrate, but she gets fair marks and I presume that is the best she can do.

Radio morning, noon and night when she is home, and the more blood-chilling the program, the more interesting it is to Shirley. Thank goodness, however, she does like to vary her entertainment.

At school she is a second lieutenant in the Girls Auxiliary Corps, which brings her face to face with the national spotlight. Although that hardly would be necessary for she has brother, Corp. George Temple, Jr., in the Marine Corps.

She is a very much interested in both patriotic and charitable groups, which is very gratifying to me. One cannot be selfish and participate in this work, too.

Has No Longer Blended

Shirley today is about 5 feet, 1 inch tall and weighs 105 pounds. She does not grow very fast. Her hair is no longer blonde, as it was when she was little, but has turned to a golden chestnut. Neither Shirley nor I would sanction any change in it.

I know most mothers have to go through the makeup problem. Shirley never did use much makeup, even in pictures. Today she uses a little lipstick, but never enough to be conspicuous. We permit her to use a little pale pink polish, but her makeup kit is small indeed.

Shirley is at the age where another year is a source of joy to her. She has no fear of growing older, but in fact welcomes it.

Has Most Everything

She eats most everything, likes meat, vegetables, eggs and milk, but little dessert. It is no trouble seeing that she gets all the vitamins she needs. She sells a lunch breakfast, but does enjoy a good helping of orange juice.

Naturally, I have some problems with Shirley that other mothers do not have. While she is on the radio or working in a picture, we have to be very careful that she is not subjected to exposure, for a cold would mean that she would be unable to work with consequent loss to her studio. She seems very healthy, for which we are duly grateful.

We have no other plans for her at the moment other than to continue her radio work, which does not interfere with her schooling.

Her dad and I feel that one picture a year, or two at the most, is all that we will consider for her during this period when her health and important development are so important.

Russians Indicate Initiative Firmly in Hands Of Red Army on Both Izyum - Barvenkova And Kharkov Sectors Of Major Battlefronts Of Ukraine; Nazis Try To Dig in to Hold.

Moscow, May 28.—(AP)—The Germans are being forced to give ground in both the Izyum-Barvenkova and Kharkov sectors, the Russians declared today, indicating that the initiative on both fronts is in the hands of the Red Army. Frontline dispatches said that the German attack on the Izyum-Barvenkova area, was trying to dig in on new defensive lines but that constant pressure from the counter-attacking Red Army is forcing them to fall back.

From their own freshly-fortified lines before Kharkov, the Russians said they were pushing forward. They battled heroically overnight against German tank and infantry forces in both sectors and reported that before Kharkov a three-day battle had burned or otherwise knocked out 46 German tanks.
