Axis Forces Move Up to Within 15 Miles of Matruk

Positions of Armored Divisions Indicate Advance of 15 Miles Along Coast, Curbed Only by Light Parrying Action of British.

Cairo, June 27.—(AP)—British headquarters reported today that Axis forces of Field Marshal Erwin Rommel had moved up to within 15 miles of Matruk, about 115 miles into Egypt from the Libyan frontier.

The positions of Axis armored divisions indicated a 15-mile advance along the coast toward Matruk, which is only light parrying action of British mobile forces.
