Transit Firms Make Surveys - Report On All Equipment to ODT.

Hartford, July 9.-Connecticut transit companies have been asked to give an accounting to the Office of Defense Transportation of the state of their equipment to carry out ODT conservation policies and the results obtained through these efforts. It was announced today by the Office of War Information.

Letters accompanying the purpose of the survey, accompanied by a memorandum setting forth in detail the kind of information desired, have been mailed to a total of 1,100 street car and bus companies throughout the country, to state regulatory bodies and to all local regulatory authorities having jurisdiction over transit operations. Detailed statements must be submitted to the ODT not later than July 15.

Changes Reported - The street car and bus companies are expected to report what changes they have made in their operations since the meeting of the American Transit Association last February, when the broad outlines of the ODT transit conservation program were discussed.

Any and all steps taken to save equipment, especially rubber tire vehicles that improve the efficiency of their operations, must be described. Restoration of old vehicles to service, rearrangement of interiors to increase passenger capacity, use of second-hand equipment and other transit-saving expedients are also to be reported. Moreover, the operators are expected to show what they have done to encourage patrons to walk to and from work, steps taken to insure the efficient use of state automobiles in their communities, and will also provide a complete inventory of their equipment and the number of vehicles of all types in service on a typical day in May.
