





Add enough flour to make a soft dough that will not stick. Knead until dough is smooth and clastic. Put in tightly covered bowl and cover dough with waxed paper. Store in refrigerator and use as needed. Dough will keep a week or more.

To make Cloverieaf Bolls, form dough into small balls that will fit a muffin pan about one-half fuil. Place three balls of dough in each greased muffin pan. Let rise until light or double in bulk. Bake at 400 degrees 12 to 18 minutes, depending on the size of the pans used. Yield: 8 dozen medium-sized rolls.
