Strict Spacing Is Advocated

Autoists Are Warned to Save on Gasoline for the Next Period.

Hartford, Sept. 21.—(AP)—Strict spacing in the use of gasoline ration coupons was advocated today by State O.P.A. Director Chester Bowles on the eve of the second period of the permanent rationing program.

Looking back, he saw thousands of drivers not entitled to extra gasoline using up their "A" coupons before conclusion of the first two-month period because of not spacing them as prescribed.

He also observed that many motorists who failed to use their supplementary gasoline allowance properly have been swamping the local gas stations with requests for additional coupons.

Last Fall Nov. 22. In announcing that 20 coupons of the basic "A" book would be valid through Nov. 22, Bowles pointed out that motorists should use four gallons of gasoline each. While the use of coupons provide the driver with only 20 gallons of gasoline to last through the month, he explained that the monthly gas budget prescribed allows 150 miles of the month's 240 miles for personal driving.
