Rationing of fuel oil this winter, already ordered for 40 states, may be on the way for owners. Owners of fuel-heated homes can best insure against heat by converting to coal. It is impossible, proper insulation and furnace care can make oil do more work. Saving up to 50% can be achieved by following the suggestions given here, based on recommendations of fuel and appliance firms. Coal and gas burners will also benefit by taking most of these steps.

How To Save Fuel

1 WEATHER STRIP doors and windows to block drafts from house. You can also save oil by installing storm doors and windows and insulating roof and walls.

2 SHUT OFF heat from rooms you use only occasionally. If you use bedroom windows at night, turn off radiators and shut doors leading to other rooms.

3 NORMALLY you may not need to heat your furnace if you do, keep temperature only slightly above freezing. Get furnace open when car is running.

4 CLEAN HEATING SYSTEM. Remove soot and carbon from firebox walls and fire passages. Clean flue pipe leading from furnace to chimney.

5 INSULATE your heating plant by applying coat of asbestos. Furnace outside should be only warm to touch; keep boiler room warm and needs insulation.

6 KEEP DOORS of furnace tightly closed at all times. Get service man to seal furnace cement all leaks that allow air to enter furnace above the fire.

7 ADJUST BURNER to proper position so that flame is proportion to air. Service man should do this. Replace broken and cracked pipes in furnace.

8 REDUCE thermostat setting to 68 degrees, engineers estimate that every 3% of fuel can be saved for every degree temperature is lowered.
