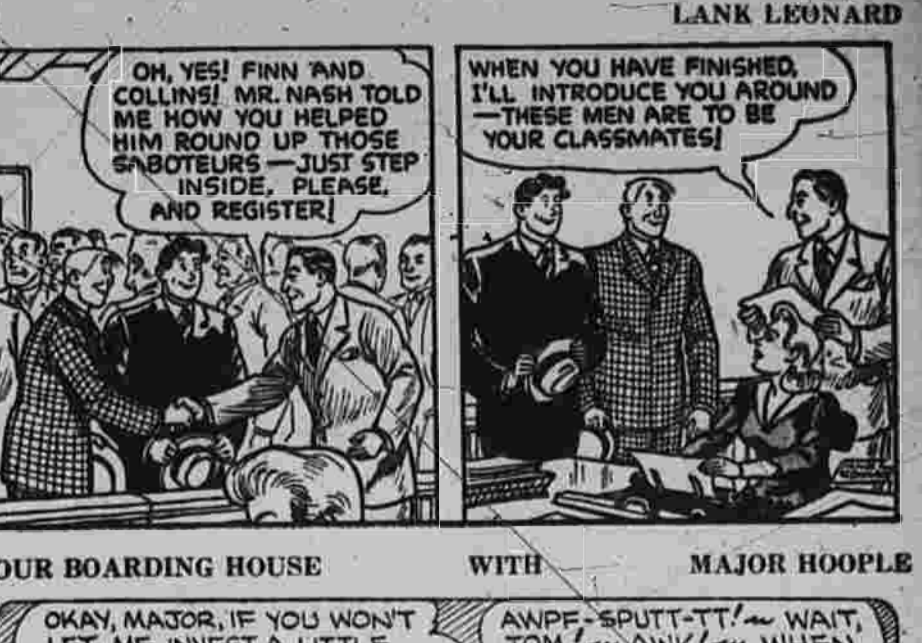

Repeats Claim Baldwin Aided Company Unit

Hurley Denies He Ever Charged Workers in Stratford Plant Organizational 'Company Unit'

Hartford, Oct. 12-AP. Gov. Robert A. Hurley denied today that he had ever charged workers in the Voight-Sikorsky factory at Stratford with forming a "company unit" on a personal note.

"I charged Raymond E. Baldwin in the secretary of state's office at Hartford, written by Mr. Baldwin in his own hand and on the private stationery introducing this man as 'worthy of your confidence' and stating that 'any assistance you could give him would be greatly appreciated.'" This letter was written to give him approval by the office of the secretary of state of the incorporation of the company.

"Did you ever stop to wonder about the purpose of the rush was to thwart the organizing efforts of both the P. O. of L. and the C. I. O.? And did you know that the company had at that time prepared a set of rules and regulations for employees forbidding organization activities on company time and property, but that it held up the issuance of these regulations until the company union was established?"

"You state that you went to the Stratford factory to organize the company union, but you did not know that Mr. Baldwin had previously telephoned to the bank and recommended this loan for you and had been repaying the loan, he would be a candidate for public office. He claims to be a friend of labor. When a candidate claims labor's friendship it is necessary and proper and in the public interest to study the individual's record of association with labor and to see whether it can stand the light of day."

"Are you fully aware of the extent of Baldwin's participation in the formation of this company union?"

"I was. You know, for example, that organizers of the company union were told by the factory manager of the Stratford plant on Thursday, Sept. 11, 1941, that Mr. Baldwin was to be their attorney and that the question of money or a retainer fee was not to be discussed with Mr. Baldwin because that was taken care of."

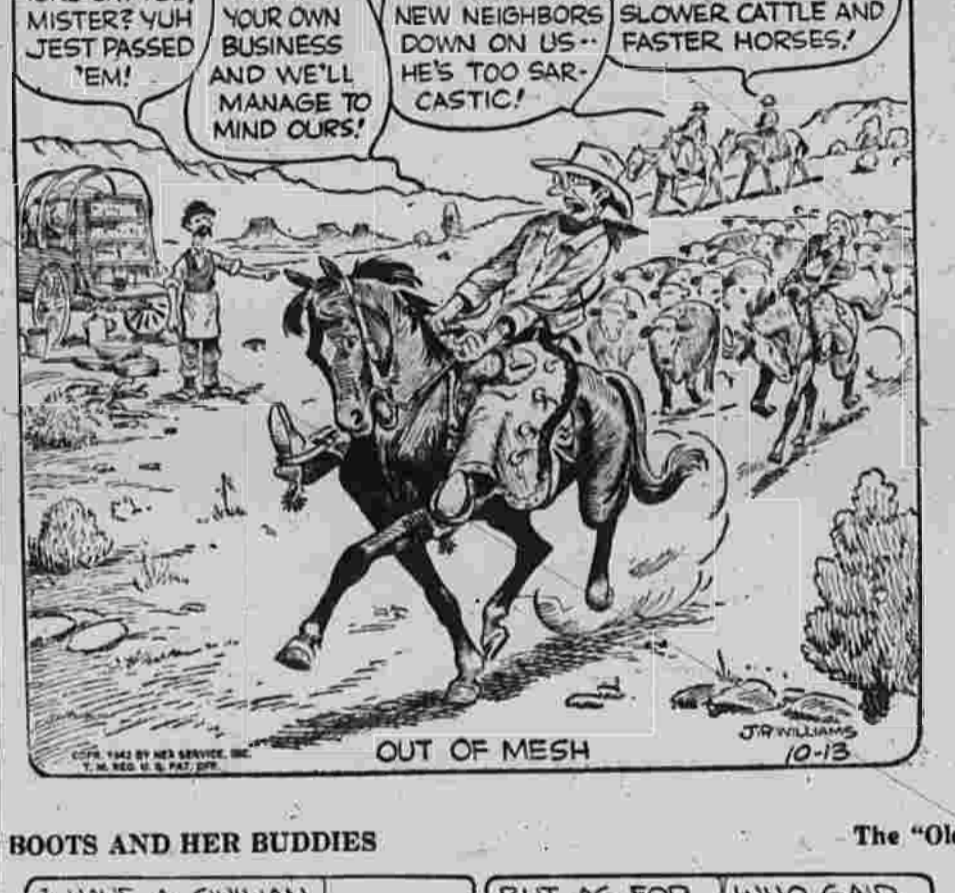
"And do you know that on Sept. 15, 1941, the active organizers of the company union went to Mr. Baldwin's home and there were received by their designated attorney at the early hour of 8 o'clock of a Saturday morning?"

"And were you aware that Mr. Baldwin drove immediately with these men to his office and there dictated the articles of organization of the Independent Brotherhood of Aircraft Workers of Stratford, Conn., Inc. and that he telephoned to the town clerk of Stratford and asked him to open his office on Sunday at 8 p. m. to take acknowledgment of the signatures of the incorporators of this organization?"

"Did you ask yourself why Mr. Baldwin, who admits that he knows the incorporation papers, did not himself take the acknowledgment of the signatures of the incorporators of the company?"

"You must know that as a Commissioner of the Superior Court he was vested with the authority to do so."
