Kentucky Aids Crop Harvest

Mountain Farmers Sent To Ease Labor Pinch In Other States.

Frankfort, Ky., Oct. 21.—(AP)—Kentucky mountaineers, who for generations have eked out a living on acreage yielding the gainful, early fall crops this year in the fertile valleys of New York and Connecticut and other distant states.

Approximately 1,000 men and women, some taking their children along, have been sent by the National Farm Security Administration to help overcome farm-labor shortages in other states.

Most of the workers went from Martin county on the West Virginia border, an isolated district

which has only a couple of telephones, and no telegraph.

Others went from mountain counties in eastern Kentucky—carefully chosen by Kentucky State Farm Placement Director Horace Cleveland from communities which do not have too mines or other industries that need workers.

First Trip From Home.

For many of the workers, Cleveland said, it was their first trip away from home, and the wages paid—40 cents an hour—represented small fortunes to families whose cash income in many instances had averaged around \$200 a year.

Some 700 went during September to help pick late potatoes, onions and other crops around Rochester and Buffalo, N. Y., and in Connecticut and New Jersey.

Then came calls for help in picking apples near Benton, Harbor, Mich., and others were sent to another group went to Maryland to help harvest apples in other states.

The workers were sent on special trains after signing contracts

to work at least 30 days, though they could work 60 if they desired. They also had to promise not to work anywhere except on farms while away from home.

The FSA guaranteed cost of transportation, meals and medical care both going and coming and arranged temporary cases for them.

"They have simply transported Martin county, or Johnson county to another state," Cleveland said, "so far as the crops are concerned. The people will live in separate camps from workers of other states."

All reports that have come back show they are making good, and that more are wanted.

Prior to the movement to other states, Cleveland had moved several hundred mountain folk to Shelby and other fertile Kentucky counties where more help was needed to harvest crops. He plans soon to send several hundred to help gather the big hemp crop in Henderson and Union counties in Kentucky near the Illinois border, where land is level and rich.

Metal Moving Toward Mills

Incomplete Reports Received More Than 3,500,000 Tons Taken.

New York, Oct. 21.—(AP)—Millions of old metal piled up during the newspaper-sponsored collection drive were moving today toward America's scrap-hungry steel mills.

Incomplete reports from 47 states showed more than 3,500,000 tons had been melted and headed for the steel mills.

The United States Steel Corp. said the total was 1,600,000 tons, and that trend indicated the final total would be 2,000,000 tons.

Scrap moved during the drive was expected to make certain the war-busy steel mills and free scrap during the winter, when scrap ordinarily becomes scarce.

Steel industry sources added their thanks to those of War Transportation Chief Donald Nelson, and said the newspaper drive had encouraged millions to build up stockpiles of scrap.

On the heels of the newspaper drive, individuals were asked to contribute scrap and many local committees planned to continue their work.
