- Meat and Vegetable Pie: 3 cups cubed carrots, 1 cup peas, 1/2 cup cauliflower flowerets, 1/2 lb. beef liver, 2 tablespoons fat or salad oil, 2 tablespoons flour, 1/2 teaspoon salt, Few grains pepper, 1 teaspoon grated onion, 1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce, 10 wheat shred crackers. Lamb Steak and Kidney Stew: 3 lamb kidneys, 1 1/2 lbs. lamb shoulder, 1/2 cup minced onion, 2 tablespoons fat or salad oil, 2 cups boiling water, 1 cup cubed carrot, 8 halved carrots, 6 white onions, Salt and pepper, 2 cups cooked or canned peas. Wash kidneys; split. Remove fat, membrane; dice kidneys and lamb. Brown with minced onion in fat or salad oil; add water. Cover; simmer 1 hour. Add carrots, onions, cover; simmer 1 hour. Remove halved carrots, onions. Thicken stock; season; pour into casserole; garnish with halved carrots, onions, peas. Bake in hot oven (400°F.) 20 minutes. Serves 4.

To Take Charge of Program for Family Day On November 1.

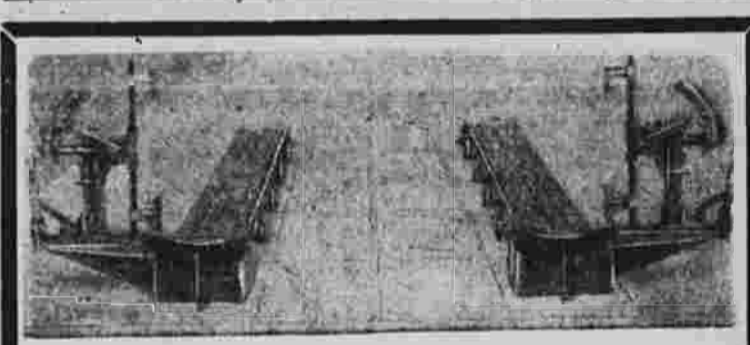
