Yankee Fighters Down Four More Planes in Desert

Continue Punishing Air Offensive in Support Of British Thrust Against Axis Lines; Airmen Apparently Sharing 3 Missions.

Cairo, Oct. 28.—(P)—United States fighter pilots have added four more Messerschmitts to their steeply-rising toll of downed enemy planes in continuation of the punishing air offensive which supports the British Eighth Army's thrust against Marshal Rommel's desert lines, official reports said today.

While air attacks smashed at enemy supply lines and bases even across the Mediterranean to Great Britain headquarters announced that the land forces had broken off a counter-offensive against the Axis in a series of minor tank engagements.

United States medium bombers struck again behind Rommel's line, according to reports from the front, and land convoys and starting many fire. Although many of the men fighting were seen in the area, the communiqué said, the bombers were not attacking some areas, attributed to the ceiling.
