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Getting Fuel Books Ready

Head of Oil Rationing Division Is Completing The Details.

Edson M. Bailey, principal of Manchester High school, who heads the local oil rationing committee, has plans well underway for distributing the 5,254 ration books received in the two days so far.

All of the applications have been turned over to him and he has arranged to start Monday with the hope of having the ration books ready to distribute before the end of next week.

It has been decided, first of all, not to try to have the work at the Lincoln school because of the lack of space. The plan is to have 40 persons computing the amount of oil allowed on each application. This work requires experienced help as there are 16 different operations for each application that has to be checked.

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Haight to Get Death in Chair

Smiles When Jury Finds Him Guilty of Two Murder Charges.

White Plains, N. Y., Nov. 6.—(AP)—Seventeen-year-old Edward Haight must die in the electric chair for the slaying of two little sisters.

The Stamford, Conn., laborer smiled in Westchester county court yesterday when a jury of six men and six women found him guilty on two first degree murder charges.

The jurors deliberated 96 minutes after hearing testimony as to how Haight on Sept. 14, lured Margaret, 7, and Helen Lynch, 8, to a nearby railroad station.

The defense retained a psychiatrist in an attempt to prove that Haight was insane, but the state called two psychiatrists who testified that the child was found in a shallow stream near their Bedford Village, N. Y., home.

When District Attorney Gilbert T. Callahan displayed a photograph of the children's bodies, two jurors wept in silent tears.

Throughout the trial, Haight retained the carefree attitude he had displayed ever since his arrest, and while the defense and prosecution argued the case, he frequently nodded agreement.
