New Cases Of Smallpox

Thousands Vaccinated In Philadelphia; Total In Outbreak Now 48.

Philadelphia, Jan. 2.—(AP)—Thousands of doctors, nurses, patients and employees in Philadelphia hospitals were vaccinated against small pox yesterday and today as the disease spread to the city.

It is an outbreak which developed only yesterday and today as the disease spread to the city.

Three large hospitals here, including the State Hospital for the Insane, and four others in the suburbs. Directors of several other institutions ordered similar measures today or within a few days.

Dr. H. H. Henshaw, chief of the health department, said that the disease will spread to this key ward in the city.

In his last report to Congress, President Roosevelt said the value of goods transferred and services rendered up to Nov. 30 was \$7,000,000 in the rate of about \$10,000,000 per month.

New York, Jan. 2.—Opera singers reputedly have high, violent temperaments and relieve themselves by singing up at the top of a note.
But Maria Markan, Metropolitan soprano from Iceland, differs from this. It is probably all mixed up in her head for it is a domestic strain, rather than opera, which dominates her existence.
Likes to sing
A generously proportioned individual with light brown hair and strong, heavy, mannerly features, Markan explains her Metropolitan success by saying, "I like to sing." About a thousand other sopranos, who "like to sing," strike out every year for the Metropolitan but when Miss Markan without an acquaintance in the country and aided only by a letter of introduction from Thor Thors, Icelandic minister to Washington, sought an audition from Edward Johnson, manager of the Metropolitan, she was given a contract immediately.
For twelve years she had been steadily climbing toward this goal. Her training took place in Germany and it was in Hamburg she made her operatic debut as Leonore in "Il Trovatore."
Sang Before Kings
In a professional tour through the Scandinavian countries she was made a Knight of the Order of the Icelandic Falcon by King Christian of Denmark and she sang before King Haakon of Norway and King Gustaf of Sweden.
Her musical background was considerably enhanced by appearances at the Glyndeborne festival, the English equivalent of Bayreuth's Salzburg festival. In 1935, she took up residence in Copenhagen and was featured on the radio.
A similar radio contract was offered to her in Australia in April of 1940. She closed her home, purchased a round trip ticket and sailed for "down under." She has never had a chance to use the ticket. The Germans invaded Denmark before her contract expired and her next port of call was Canada.
The English she had begun to learn at Glyndeborne and improved in Australia were abandoned by her and she drew on it again for professional appearances in Vancouver and Winnipeg but apparently she was saying "go to New York," the old slogan.
Just one week after her Metropolitan debut last January she became the wife of another Icelandic, George Ostlund, who has been in American business for nearly 30 years.
It is the role of Mrs. Ostlund she prefers even to her favorite professional one, Leonore in "Il Trovatore." They live in a seven room apartment in Spanglers Bay, all on the Hudson river and last week when the servant shortage became a personal problem she even tackled the laundry herself.
Up at Spanglers, the maid, Markan cooks and bakes. Wechsels in winter the bed and her husband's ski. New York's weather shrivels her, Iceland was ever like this, she mutters against the wind.
