Must Carry Draft Cards

All Registrants Who Are in 18-38 Age Class Should Have Them.

Hartford, Jan. 15.—All men in the State of Connecticut between the ages of 18 and 38, who have been subject to Selective Service registration for as long as six months and who do not have their classification cards, were advised today by John F. Robinson, State Director of Selective Service, to show them to their local boards at once. On and after February 1, the director pointed out, any man in this age group, who does not have in his personal possession his Classification Card (Form 37) as well as his Certificate of Registration is liable to fine or imprisonment, or both.
