**R. G. Southwick, state chair-** man of the farm drive, said that the need for steel continues and this means that scrap is needed, especially heavy scrap.

**Oliver Baldwin, president** of the farm scrap quota for Connecticut this year is 12,000 gross tons, worth \$200,000. "This is a very sizeable job and means that all farms must be scrapped if this quota is met."

**The State Salvage committee,** joint sponsor of the farm drive, told Southwick that the state is relying heavily on the farms to help meet Connecticut's quota of 12,000 tons of scrap during the first half of 1943.

**Because of the inferior quality** of scrap iron and steel remaining in urban homes, there are no national plans for a household scrap iron drive in the cities.

**Less than 750 tons of the 30,000** tons of scrap piled up in Connecticut's yards in the fall drive remains to be moved from the dead-end lots, said Southwick said. "Much of this is light sheet material which must be hauled long distances and baled," he added.
