### Endless Possibilities Seen in Plastics Use

Will Not Substitute for Other Materials, But Will Supplement Those Now in Use.

By Howard W. Babcock, Associated Press Staff Editor, Pittsburgh, March 13.—The Mellon institute is making a new, leather-like plastic to last 25 years without stretching despite being flexed about 900 times an hour.

The institute also has produced a new metal-like plastic to form discs, which for 25 years must be like coins about to lose their spin, and do this in boiling hot or icy cold water, without warping, swelling or shrinking.

Both are intended for special jobs in meters. Both mislead the public, as have their near-imitations in plastics, in that when anything a man wants in materials, his house, his car, his plane, can be tailor-made to fit his dreams. Actually this might be done. Actually it probably never will happen.

Full of Scientific Miracles The plastics age, as seen here at Mellon institute, will be full of scientific miracles—but plastics won't substitute for metals, wood, bricks and stone, nor for jewels, silks and clothing. They will supplement all those and many more. They will be used to do things nature's materials cannot do well.

The situation is foretold by Dr. Reginald L. Wakeman, industrial fellow. His fellowship is supported by the Pittsburgh Equitable Meter Co.

Usually plastics will be too expensive to substitute. Cotton paving blocks, so-called because they are a plastic with a base obtained from cotton, are an example. Some of the publicity for plastics paved with cotton blocks omitted the cost—around 40 cents a pound.

When we enter a new war, the total American plastic production was less than one-half of one per cent of the metals we used. In volume, it equaled were some four per cent of the metals.

Can Be Made in All Colors A rennaissance of color is one definite change to come with plastics. They can be made in all colors. The colors are fast, with unusual brilliance and sheen. Neither dirt, corrosion nor wear permanently dims them. These colored plastics clean easily, usually by washing with water.

There is no end in sight of the variety of plastics to be made. There is also an equally endless possibility of bending plastics to other materials, or bonding the two together permanently. And today there is a war plane made mostly of wood. A resin, which is a plastic, does this. Paper is impregnated with the resin. On it is laid a thin layer of wood, one-sixty-fourth of an inch thick.

Wood planes are possible only because of the plastic, which cement the layers of wood. Virtually all the new plywood advances depend on plastics. The so-called plastic planes contain a binder, about 10 to 14 per cent of plastic.

Nylon One Of Most Versatile New persons think of nylon as a plastic. Yet it is one of the foremost, and one of the most versatile.

The mustard gas of the first world war started a typical plastic trail. Ethylene was needed in huge quantities to make this war gas. At the end of the war Edgewood Arsenal had a daily capacity of 40 tons of mustard gas. This and other plants had created a large, new source of ethylene.

Later on, huge quantities of ethylene became available as a by-product of petroleum refining. Scientists put ethylene to new uses. It went to make today's anti-freeze for auto radiators, ripe fruits and vegetables, and especially to form new plastics. This mustard gas ingredient makes some of the glass-like plastics, cable sheathing and various synthetic rubbers. It is part of tholol, the synthetic which the War Relocation Authority designated as the war stop-gap for civilian tires.

Versatility All But Incredible The versatility of plastics is all but incredible. Take paracord. It is a useful, finer binder and also an ingredient in chewing gum.

Auto safety glass is made with a plastic. Cashew nuts furnish a plastic to make high quality brake linings. The casing of milk makes an imitation wool, and that is also a plastic. In industry the plastics are more important than in household and personal uses. They furnish the rubberized and concrete paints, many of the lacquers and all sorts of adhesives. Wherever there is an industrial job in which metal is failing, the chemist can look over his field of plastics, decide what kind and arrangement of molecules will form a special material for the job, and then, if given time enough, make the article.

New Material Sources Everywhere The raw material sources are enormous. The first plastic was vulcanized rubber, the process Charles Goodyear discovered 100 years ago. The next was ebonite, from rubber, discovered by his brother, Nelson. Ebonite entered in a great way into the development of America's telephone and telegraph. Next the American John W. Hyatt developed a third plastic, celluloid. But the real start came in 1907, and was all-American too. Bakelite was produced in this year, and remained soon after.
